INTRODUCTION (CALIBRI 12, BOLD, UPPERCASE)

In the introduction section, the objectives and adequate background of the research should be provided clearly. Avoid putting detailed literature surveys or summary of the result. Explain the importance of the topic and how you addressed the problem (Calibri 12).

LITERATURE REVIEW (CALIBRI 12, BOLD, UPPERCASE)

This section should contain extensive information about literature which is used as the framework of knowledge (Calibri 12).

Sub-heading (Calibri 12, Bold, Italic)

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METHODS (CALIBRI 12, BOLD, UPPERCASE)

This section should contain sufficient information for the readers to understand the method used in the paper. It is imperative to provide detailed description of the study design, hypothesis, instrument, also statistical analysis if applicable. (Calibri 12).

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RESULT AND DISCUSSION (CALIBRI 12, BOLD, UPPERCASE)

This section should contain the result of your research and followed by a comprehensive discussion toward the result. We recommend presenting the result in a table, etc, to help readers in understanding the paper and followed by a brief explanation about the result. Avoid extensive citations and discussion of published literature, instead focus on interpreting the result. (Calibri 12).

CONCLUSION (CALIBRI 12, BOLD, UPPERCASE)

This section should contain the main conclusion of the study. It may stand alone or separated into subsections. The conclusion should be clear and lead the reader into the important matter of the paper. It also can be followed by managerial implications and recommendations for further research. (Calibri 12).

REFERENCES (CALIBRI 12, BOLD, UPPERCASE)

We recommend using software such as Mendeley for the references. AJLM adopts APA style. List of references should be typed in Calibri 12 Normal; Sentence Case; paragraph: line spacing 1 lines; before: 0 pt, after: 6 pt. Here are some examples.

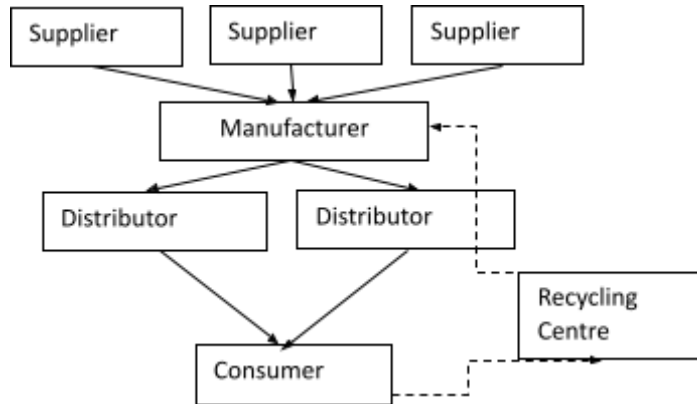


Figure 1. Reverse Logistics Model
