Director of the Year Award

- Displays professionalism and decorum at all times.
- The award class includes one two-year director and two four-year directors.



Program of the Year Award

Student Club of the Year Award

Team of the Year Award

Educator of the Year Award

Production Team of the Year Award

Research Excellence Award
