Ministry of Urban Development

Minister Octavian Russell (Methedex)

1. I have taken the time to clean up the house since becoming Minister. I am still working towards this as we speak. Determining roles of every employed MUD person and what job they have done and what projects they were working on. I have required every employee to undergo training as well to become certified to actually do their jobs properly and to increase cohesion in MUD. I have made a few policies for MUD already and updated existing ones as well.

Ministry of Economic Affairs

Minister Jory Romulus (Joryrusso12)

4. It was spent on a combination of pilot programs, grants, and employee bonuses.
