What is the Senior Class Party?

The Senior Class Party is an alcohol free, after graduation celebration honoring the Class of 2022. The party is being planned for 5/29/2022 and will once again be held at Air Madness in Harrisburg. Graduates will arrive between 9:30 -10:00pm and will be safely secured within the venue until 5:00am.

Together as a class the new graduates celebrate one last time together via 135,000 square feet of entertainment, with food, prizes, and soooo much more (jump area, laser tag, gyms, turf, escape rooms etc)!

How do I buy my Senior a ticket?

Early bird rates for the 2022 Senior Class Party are \$50. Ticket fees will be raised to \$60 after April 1. Money from ticket fees will go toward the venue cost, additional entertainment, and prizes. This year there will be several options to purchase a ticket:

Is a Registration Form required?

The Senior Class Party is largely funded by profits made from concessions sold during volleyball, basketball, wrestling and gymnastics competitions, as well as other generous community and family donations.

As spectator participation was limited last year, concession revenue was down and not as strong as previous years. Therefore...... Typical carryover from one class to the next was limited and additional monetary support is needed to make this event happen in 2022!
