Thunder Ridge High School Dance Guidelines

The following policies ensure an environment where all students and adults feel safe and comfortable. Dance guidelines will be enforced at the discretion of the Thunder Ridge High School administration and staff. Students and/or their guests who violate these guidelines may be immediately removed from the dance, have their parents called, and may be prohibited from attending future dances and activities. The ticket prices will not be refunded if a student is asked to leave the dance.

General Guidelines

- Students are not permitted to leave the dance and return. Doors may be opened under the supervision of a school administrator/chaperone to promote air circulation.
- TRHS administration has the right to search any handbags, bags, parcels, etc. Students are encouraged to NOT bring these items to the dance.
- NO outside containers, drinks, bottles, cans, etc.
- School rules apply at all dances.
- Students must present their tickets to gain entrance into the dance.
- All students and guests must have a valid student ID to be admitted to the dance.
- Students will be sent home for inappropriate dancing or behavior.
- The school is not responsible for articles lost or stolen at the dance.
- Any student who engages in fighting, harassment, or other disruptive behavior shall be immediately dealt with by the administrator on duty.
- TRHS students are admitted individually. If attending as a couple, one of the students must be from Thunder Ridge High School or live within the TRHS boundaries AND attend TCHS, BOHS, or Lincoln High School.
- Students bringing a guest from another school must fill out a guest form and return it to the school no later than 1 day before the dance.
- If inappropriate dancing, pushing, moshing, etc. occurs, the lights will be turned on and/or music stopped as a collective warning for everyone.
- The dress expectations for dances shall be enforced. Clothing should be appropriate, and all articles of clothing shall remain fastened, buttoned, and otherwise worn. Suitcoats, jackets, shawls, and other exterior items may be removed as situations allow.
- Students under the influence of mood-altering chemicals or alcohol will be detained, the parents/guardians and police will be called, and the students will be removed from the dance.
