Beyond Coal

Recently, the Wall Street Journal reported Lightstone Generation, which owns the Gavin coal plant in Cheshire, Ohio, is seeking a debt exchange with lenders to extend its \$1.7 billion loan by three years, from 2024 to 2027. Sierra Club has called on Gavin's lenders, all of which have policies that restrict financing for coal-fired power plant generation, to decline any refinancing arrangement that would prolong operation of the plant or make any postponement conditional on Lightstone's commitment to retiring Gavin as soon as practicable.
