Coronavirus Economic Response (Vaccine Target Jobkeeper Extension) Amendment Bill 2021

OUTLINE

This bill extends the jobkeeper period from the current expiration of the 30th of June 2021, to the earliest of two criteria, 31 December 2021, or until data from the Department of Health demonstrates that 75% of Australians above the age of 16 have been fully vaccinated.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

It's estimated to have a financial impact of 43,900m in the 2021-22 financial year, if the period ends on the 31st of December 2021.
