DIVORCE RECOVERY The Church understands the pain of those for whom divorce seemed the only recourse. The emotional and spiritual needs of the separated and divorced require special attention. They are urged to make frequent use of the sacraments, especially the Sacraments of Holy Eucharist and Reconciliation.

Divorced persons who wish to marry in the Catholic Church are encouraged to seek counsel from their parish priest or minister about the options to remedy their situation, including the suitability of a declaration of nullity when there is no longer any hope of reconciliation of the spouses.
