Gear icon: Check settings regarding your account including your profile pic and email notifications. Seesaw for Schools: Student information synced from Skyward. Principals can add staff. Teachers can add support staff as co-teachers. Standards/ skills have been added by grade level Wrench icon: Check settings about your class, such as creating folders, options for family access, blog and student posts settings. Navigation: See the feed, student work and folder work. Specialists: Library, PE and Music will share one Seesaw class per homeroom teacher. Each specialist class will have a folder for PE, a folder for Music and a folder for Library. We are working out best practices on how these will be auto created for you. Once all programs are syncing for the new year, we will have a solution. Parent & Family Supports

- **Communication**
 - **ParentSquare** for all message for families (more in a later unit)
 - **Class App:** The Seesaw app for students to complete work.
 - **Family App:** The Seesaw app for families. Families only have access to their students' work, and can't see grades. Up to 10 family members per student.
- **Family Settings:** Go to the wrench to adjust your settings for families to meet your needs.
- **Invite Families:** Get the link and send through ParentSquare later. *(Not an option until students are in your Seesaw Class)*
- **Announcements:** Please do not use for communicating with families, only students. To communicate with families, use ParentSquare.
- **Blog:** Great way to share samples from all students to families. Creates a website for the public, and may choose a password. Similar to a star work wall. Only student first names are visible. Get this setup now, and we will use in a later unit.
