

Covid-19 Schema Examples

Building on the initial [covid-19 schema changes](#) at Schema.org, some examples.

When the content stabilizes, this can be published (HTML, PDF etc.) on Schema.org and elsewhere. For now, we are using Google Docs for collaboration.

Status: Public examples for collaboration. The markup will be contributed into Schema.org and is available also for use in other guideline docs. We can expand the list of examples to cover any areas of uncertainty and to capture common patterns. [Version 7.01](#) of Schema.org was published March 22nd including improvements developed here.

Text from section of this page:

- Meals for Students During Closure
 - PAUSD will continue to provide nutritious meals to all students who need them during the temporary closure of schools.
 - PAUSD continuara proporcionando comidas nutritivas a todos los estudiantes que las necesiten durante el cierre temporal de las escuelas.
 - More text is provided - we only need a short summary in the schema markup, but a deep link into the correct section of the page is preferred so that users can be sent to the right place to read the rest.

Notes:

- The notice about PAUSD school meals is made in both English and Spanish; we model that here as two distinct SpecialAnnouncement items
- Ideally each specific translated announcement has a distinct URL (eg. #something on same URL)
- Need to add a /SchoolDistrict type under <https://schema.org/AdministrativeArea>

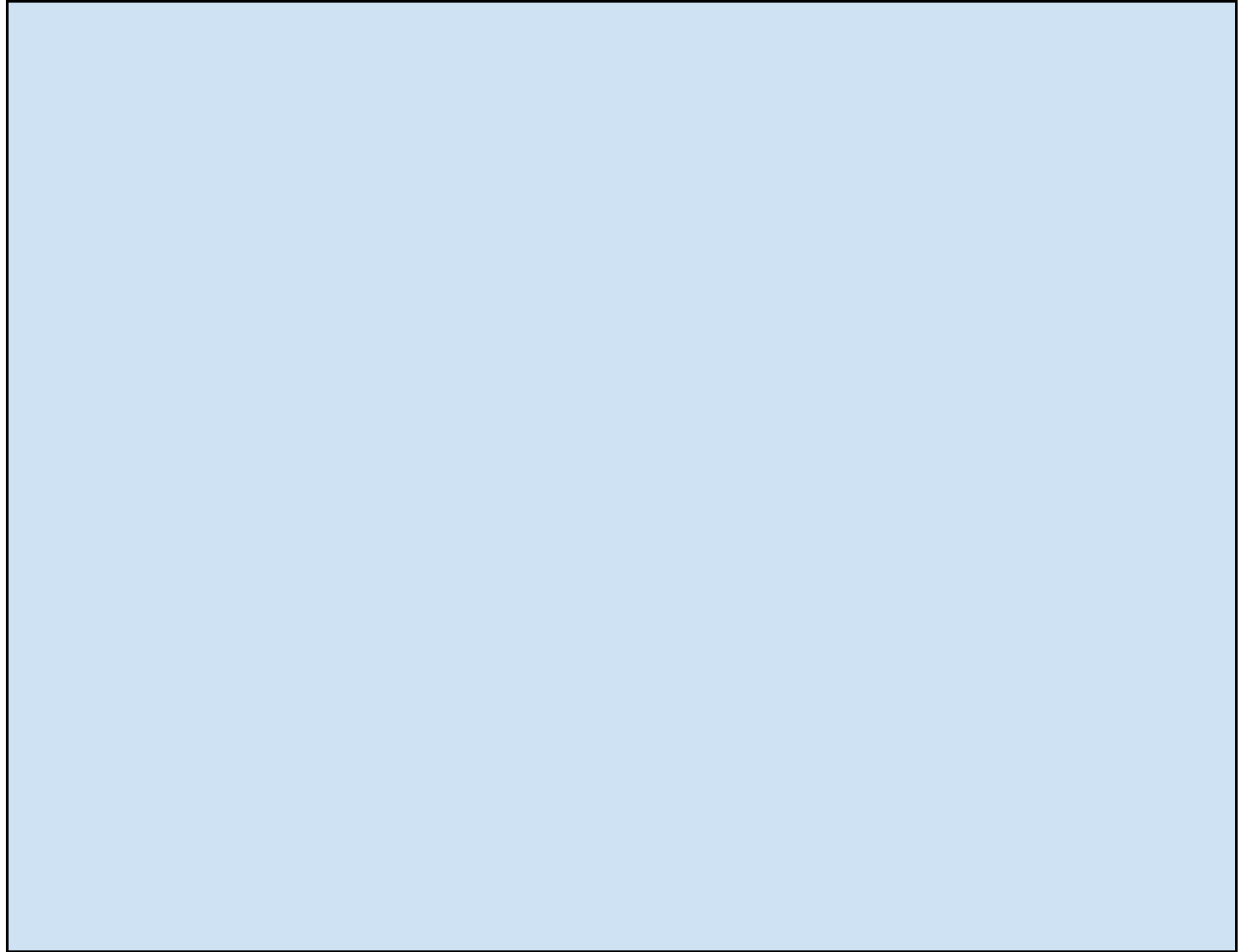

Notes:

- There are several different tables, each with their own notes, titles, metadata, and column headers.
- It feels like a lot to ask for folks to fully describe the statistical population, etc., so maybe we just ask for a label and a link to a CSV for the table.
- These are updated multiple times per day, so it's important to have the time part of datePosted.

General Notes and FAQs

- Q: Would new updates always override old updates?
- A: Generally, no. You could have an update on Monday "Please stay offsite, phone to arrange visits" and on Tuesday "If you have possessions on site, call the caretaker's office.". In this case the announcements are more blog-like (i.e. rss/atom-style dated items). Furthermore, the expressivity of the schema allows for overlapping updates, so we would need some way to resolve the updates as well.

CDC Hospital reporting Schema
