Every Kindergarten student needs...

Headphones: (the ones linked are a great option that have lasted all year) We are 1 to 1 with iPads here at Oakwood. Each child will need his/her own set of headphones. When buying these, please be sure they fit your child's head and they are not wireless. Write your child's name on them, put in a zip-loc bag and send them in on the First Day of School.

At Home Supplies: We know that children love to go and pick out school supplies. We supply crayons, glue, pencils and anything else that they may need. The children will be having homework every week. A wonderful idea would be to have all the supplies they might need in a special box labeled: "My Homework Supplies". Your child can take out his/her box to complete his/her homework. Make this a special box which your child will only use for homework and not for playtime, or to share with friends or siblings.

Here is a list of some of the supplies your child will need to do their homework. Let them take ownership and pick out what they put in their box.

* Crayons * markers * colored pencils * pencils * scissors

Change of Clothes:

Important...in case of spills or accidents, please send an extra outfit including underwear, pants, shirt and socks in a gallon-sized Ziploc bag labeled with your child's first and last name. These will be kept in the front pocket of your child's backpack. The clothes may need to be swapped out based on season and as kids grow. If your child has an accident, please be sure to send back clean clothes to replace the soiled clothes that are sent home to be put back in your child's backpack.

Lunch and Snack:

Students have about 20 minutes to eat lunch. Please help your child practice opening containers and packages this summer to help prepare them for lunch. There are staff to help with this, but their independence with this task will help them feel more confident and make them feel more at ease while eating lunch.

Snack time in the classroom will depend on what time we have lunch. Snack will be about 10-15 minutes and we ask that you send a snack that is labeled with your child's name and is something healthy and low in sugar.

Make sure water bottles are spill and leak proof.
