Description: Cow breed that originated in Normandy France. Primarily bred for milk and meat needs for northwestern France. Present herd books date to 1883.

Characteristics: Medium frame with small head and most cows weighing 1200 to 1500 and bulls 2000 to 2400 pounds. Have a strong top line along the back

Color: Red and White with occasional areas of brown brindle.
