The Magellan Charter School Board of Directors is proud to offer an annual \$1000 academic scholarship to a Magellan Graduate/rising college freshman. This scholarship is designed to assist former Magellan students as they continue their educational journey. Accordingly, the scholarship awarded will only be paid to the winning applicant if he/she has been accepted as a student in any accredited university, college, junior college, community college or technical/trade institute as of December 31st in the year in which the scholarship is awarded. If the winning applicant has not been accepted by this date, the scholarship will be forfeited.

Scholarship funds will be awarded to the winning applicant after receipt of documentation indicating that the applicant has been accepted, within time constraints, as a student in any accredited university, college, junior college, community college or technical/trade institute.

Completed applications will be submitted to the Scholarship Selection Committee **no later than Friday, March 6, 2026**. Completed applications should be delivered or mailed to the Magellan Charter School. Under **no circumstances** will applications be accepted after this date. Applicants are advised to be aware of this deadline and are encouraged to submit their applications early.

Qualifications for an interview will be based on your essay and application. Not all applicants may qualify for an interview. Interviews are before a panel of judges, approximately 15 minutes in length, and will be held in person on **Thursday, March 26, 2026** (after school) This is the only date interviews will be conducted.
