Assessment Task 2 - Term 2, 2012

This term we will be looking at the use of computers to work with digital media - text, images, audio and video - by creating a series of short multimedia projects. You will be **given one media project on Monday each week** of Term 2 and you will need to **submit it by Sunday night** at the end of that same week. This gives you a whole week to complete each task.

Each task will take some time to complete - normally about an hour or so. It might take a bit less or it might take a bit more, it really just depends on you. You can work on it in class time, or in your own time, but you need to complete each project every week.

It's also up to you to come up with the idea for how you will respond to the weekly project, work out how you will actually make it, and learn any skills you need to make it. Of course, I will try to assist you wherever I can, but the ultimate responsibility to create, make and publish each of these tasks is up to you! Let me repeat that last sentence... **the ultimate responsibility to create, make and publish each of these tasks is up to you.**

Remember, each task is due on the Sunday night of the week it was given. These tasks form the entirety of your Term 2 mark.
