F.27 PARTICIPATION OF HOME STUDY STUDENTS IN SCHOOL PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES

(REQUIRED)

I. Policy

In accordance with Act 119 of the 1998 Vermont legislative session it is the policy of the North Country Supervisory Union to encourage home study students to participate in courses, programs, activities, and services and use school educational materials and equipment. Close communications between home study students and their local public schools are encouraged to promote the benefits of joint participation.

II. Background

A. The North Country Supervisory Union recognizes that some families believe home schooling is the best educational format for their children. The North Country Supervisory Union believes that home study and fully enrolled students can benefit from participating together in school activities and programs and strives to provide educational services in ways, which are consistent with the needs of both fully enrolled students and home study students.
