Spirit Week Themes & Dress Guidelines

While participation is optional, we encourage all students to show their school spirit and join in the fun. To participate, students must bring their uniforms each day. Failure to bring the full, regular school uniform risks students being unable to attend classes. All attire must conform to school rules and should be glorifying God. Tuesday, 10/14 – Pajama Day: Wear pajamas with **long pants only**—no shorts, slippers, flip flops, crocs or uggs.

Wednesday, 10/15 – Best Dressed: Business formal attire. Dress like you are going to an interview. Skirts to the knee.

Thursday, 10/16 – Character Day: Dress as a comic book, book, or movie character. Make sure your character is easily recognizable and identifiable. **If it is not recognizable to adult leadership in the school or if it is deemed inappropriate, you will be asked to change into your uniform**. Friday, **10/17** – Friday is Spiritual Life Day! Students will enjoy exciting physical activities, so please remember to **wear clothing and sneakers** that allow you to participate comfortably.
