What I Liked

Loki is a character known for doing unexpected things that nobody saw coming. True to the title character this series constantly subverted my expectations. In every episode, something would happen that I didn't see coming, especially in Episode 5. None of the stuff that happened in this episode was foreshadowed at all until the post credits scene of episode 4, it just came out of nowhere and I absolutely love it. In fact, Episode 5 is probably my favorite episode. Loki himself is just as fun as ever and Mobius also is a great addition to the series. I also loved how episode 6 set up Kang as the MCU's next big bad.

What I Disliked

While I do like that Kang was set up for a big part in the MCU, that's all that really happened in the finale. The finale was the big payoff of the past 5 weeks of Loki, but all that really happened in it was exposition and setup for the MCU's future. That's not to say I didn't like the exposition and setup, it did excite me for the future of the MCU, but I wish the finale had a bit more action to it.
