- Students will actively participate in daily rehearsals and all classroom activities.
- Students will be on time and be prepared with music, pencil, and other necessary materials.

ATTENDANCE

- A grade will be given for each performance. An absence from a performance will result in a "zero" performance grade for the nine weeks in which the absence occurred. Leaving during a concert, for any reason, will result in a "75" as your performance grade. Being late to the call will result in "10" points off your performance grade.
- Many of you will have part-time employment. You will always be given ample prior notice of rehearsals and concerts, and you will be expected to make arrangements with your employer to attend these rehearsals and performances. Also, many of you are involved in other EHS and community activities that will, from time to time, conflict with our rehearsals and performances. You are expected to do all in your power to make arrangements to attend these required events. If you need to make arrangements with another EHS sponsor, let your director know.
- If you have extenuating circumstances and cannot attend a rehearsal or performance, you must personally submit your reason for needing to miss to the director <u>by email **2 weeks prior** to the rehearsal or performance</u>. If you are absent from school the day of an after-school rehearsal or performance, you must contact the director prior to our performance for the absence to be excused.

Attendance at department concerts is <u>mandatory</u> for all students and is not excused for birthdays, anniversaries, etc. Absences may be excused only at Director's discretion.

SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES

CHOIR PLACEMENT

Choir placement for the following year is based on students' participation and effort throughout the year. Additionally, the directors will have each student do a sight reading evaluation at the end of the year. Directors consider students' participation, effort, attitude, and sight reading level when evaluating for choir placement for the next year.

UNIFORMS

Women: Black choir dress issued by EHS, black dress shoes (closed toe).

Men: Black tuxedo jacket, pants, and tie issued by EHS Choir. <u>BLACK dress shoes, BLACK button up shirt</u>

and BLACK dress socks will be your responsibility to provide.

Loss or damage of any part of your uniform, owned by the school, will result in fines for repair or replacement.

The uniforms will be worn at all concerts and competitions. Uniforms will be returned to school following UIL or your choir's final performance. If a student is out of uniform at a performance, he/she will not be allowed to sing and a performance grade of "zero" will be assigned. If a student needs another size uniform, it is their responsibility to notify the directors at least two weeks in advance of a performance. We will <u>not</u> address uniform issues the day of the concert. Those students not returning uniforms at the end of the year will be placed on the Delinquent List until they are returned; graduating seniors will be blocked from graduation. Girls will need their dresses cleaned at least once during the school year and any dress with strong, discernable, body odor will be considered damaged and a fine will be assessed.

<u>IF DRESSES/PANTS NEED TO BE HEMMED.</u> DO NOT LET SEAMSTRESSES/ TAILORS CUT ANY MATERIAL FROM UNIFORM!

MUSIC ENRICHMENT LESSONS

Music Enrichment Lessons are offered to all interested choir students. A payment of \$25.00 per lesson should be paid to the voice teacher on a monthly basis. (Four lessons a month @ 25.00 per = 100.00) Voice lessons are an integral part of our choral program and are highly recommended for any student who wants to excel. Every student can benefit greatly from this one-on-one instruction.

FACILITIES

The choir room at Eaton is full of expensive equipment that does not belong to you. Take pride in this and help keep it looking new. The room will not be used as a locker. Any items left in the room will be turned into the lost and found weekly.

Do NOT leave food, drink, or food related trash in the choir room or choir room trash cans. Dispose of food related trash in the Union. The office and computers are off limits to students unless given permission.

If you need to speak with a director when they are in the office, please use courtesy, knock, and wait for an invitation to enter.
