## Pond Cove School Immediate Response to School Closure (DAY ONE)

- If the school closure occurs on a WEDNESDAY, the schedule will remain the same as a normally scheduled remote Wednesday.
- If the school closure occurs on a MAROON day:
  - Teachers will post a morning message and asynchronous assignments to Google Classroom by 10:00 a.m. for MAROON cohort students and will also provide a block of time for live student check-in/support or hold a class meeting sometime between 9 am and 2 pm.
  - Gold students should follow their asynchronous schedule as usual.
  - Elected fully remote students will follow the schedule provided by their teacher.
- If the school closure occurs on a GOLD day:
  - Teachers will post a morning message and asynchronous assignments to Google Classroom by 10:00 a.m. for GOLD cohort students and will also provide a block of time for live student check-in/support or hold a class meeting sometime between 9 am and 2 pm.
  - Maroon students should follow their asynchronous schedule as usual.
  - Elected fully remote students will follow the schedule provided by their teacher.

## If school closure duration continues for a week:

- A student's previously scheduled Maroon or Gold in-person HYBRID DAY (not their scheduled remote learning day) will include a live student Morning Meeting and check-in/support time via Zoom and asynchronous Google Classroom assignments. Each classroom teacher will communicate with students/parents about scheduling for the day.
- A student's previously scheduled Maroon or Gold REMOTE DAY will be the same platform as pre-school closure.
- Elected fully remote students will continue with their current schedule.
