Hybrid Learning Workshop Plans

We are running a hybrid workshop this year. We will do in-person instruction sessions and then conduct 1:1 conferences through Google Meet. Students will attend an hour-and-a-half long in-person instruction session for three days, Monday, 6/23, Tuesday, 6/24, and Wednesday, 6/25. On the first day, students will select when their remote 1:1 conference will be on either Thursday, 6/26 or Friday, 6/27. Students should bring their Chromebook to the workshop each day.

Sessions will be capped at 25 students for each section.

Locations\Dates\Times

We will meet in a Bedford High School Classroom. The workshop will take place in person on Monday, 6/23, Tuesday, 6/24, and Wednesday, 6/25. Digital 1:1 conferences will run Thursday, 6/26 and Friday, 6/27.

Students will choose one of three sessions for the in-person instruction. Each session will meet for an hour and a half for the three instructional days. Options are as follows:

Session A 7:30-9:00

Session B 9:10-10:40

Session C 11:00-12:30

Students should ensure that they are able to attend their selected session all three days. We will not be able to swap students in and out between sessions.

Cost: \$130

We will be accepting payments only through check this year. Since we do not operate as a formal part of BHS summer school, **do not make payment out to Bedford High School!** We run this workshop as “independent contractors”.
