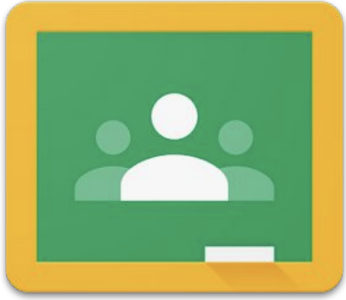


Everything you need to know about Google Classroom



What is Google Classroom?

How does my student log in to Google Classroom?

Your student will need to [visit their Clever page](#) and look for the link to Classroom that looks like the icon above or go to classroom.google.com and use their Newberg email account and password to get logged in (if they are not logged in already. If you don't know the username or password, please call or email your school.

How can parents/guardians/grown ups stay up to date on what's going on in Google Classroom?

As a guardian, you can get email summaries about your student's activity in Classroom. If you are not getting these guardian, if you're not getting these guardian summaries and would like to, please contact your student's teacher. Please note these summaries come as emails, and the email summaries do not include grades. For grades, ask your student or contact the teacher.
