- 2. d.) President Gordon B. Hinckley articulates the remarkable aspects and blessings of Brigham Young University as a college "rooted in the gospel of Jesus Christ". He organizes his speech into sections specifying what students should walk away with alongside a diploma upon graduation. He first states that we should receive intellectual discipline from our time here. This is described as a state of "mental acuity" characterized by a reliable work ethic and desire to learn. This can be accomplished through the sacrifice of time that would rather be dedicated to swing dancing and going on dates with hot guys, and through chasing the horizon that is attaining knowledge. Next, President Hinckley distinguishes students at BYU as having spirits of fellowship and a capacity for social grace which he deems crucial.
