Squat jumps!

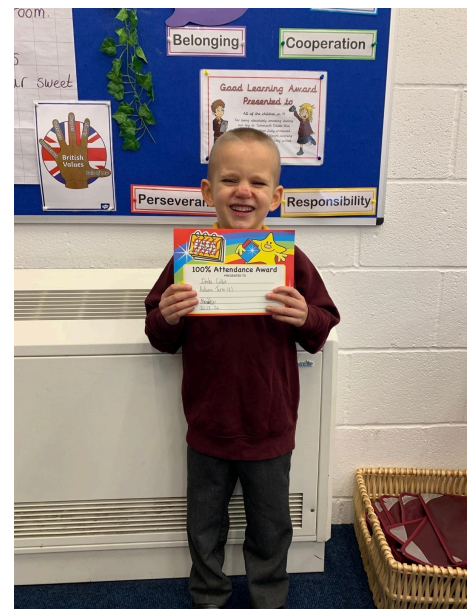
How many squat jumps can you perform in 60 seconds? Stand behind a line and jump forwards, perform a squat and repeat.
