

Dear Parents/Guardians & Students,

As the summer comes to an end and we are getting ready to welcome autumn, the yearbook staff has already begun preparations on the 2021 edition of our yearbook, Aquila. The yearbook is a wonderful way to capture all of the people, events and memories that have made your years at Hauppauge so special.

To ensure that as many students as possible are represented in the yearbook and that the books arrive to us on time, it is important that all the dates listed below are adhered to.

September 9th: Yearbook sales begin. All orders must be placed at jostensyearbook.com.

We do not accept orders in school. Prices increase throughout the year, so for the best possible deal, order early. Orders will be accepted online until mid-May. After that time, books can be purchased, cash only, at school in June while supplies last.

Sept. 17th-18: <u>Underclassmen Portrait Day</u>. Students will be going to the auditorium to have their photos taken during their regularly scheduled English classes.

September 14-September 16th: Senior Portraits: Portraits will be taken IN SCHOOL Irvin Simon will be sending home a list of portrait dates and times for all seniors. In that the photographer will not be providing a drape or tux, we ask that the following attire be worn for senior portraits:

Girls: Black Top

Boys: White button down shirt with black tie. Above listed attire is suggested..not mandatory.

TBD: Senior Portrait Retakes. Re-takes will be scheduled about 5 weeks after senior portrait day. This is the final opportunity for Seniors to have their photo taken for placement in the yearbook. If a photo is not taken by this date, the student will be listed as Camera Shy. Photos from other studios may not be used. Due to strict publisher deadlines, no exceptions will be made to this policy.

Senior Panoramic Photo. Due to Covid-19, we are unsure at this time whether the panoramic is a possibility. Please stay tuned for updates.. Any Senior who dresses or behaves inappropriately will not be permitted to appear in the photo.

Senior Portrait Pose Choice: Due by the second week in November. Please stay tuned for specific due date. Once due-date is determined, all senior poses must be chosen by this date or a default photo will be selected by the yearbook adviser. Students must select a vertical photo.

Oct. 30th: SENIORS ONLY!

These photos cannot be accepted after October 30th due to the publisher's deadlines. All photos must be uploaded to **images.jostens.com** Please be sure to label the title of the picture (ex. Baby pic, sibling pic, etc.) <u>Hard copies cannot be accepted</u>.

• IMPORTANT! Please do not upload photos for anyone other than yourself. By doing so, photos may be tagged incorrectly and errors may appear in the final copy of the yearbook. The yearbook staff is not responsible for any photos mislabeled due to uploading errors.
