Common collocations relating to age

- Disaffected youth – young people who do not accept society's values

- Feel their age – when someone feels as old as they are

- Act your age! – Behave more maturely (when someone is acting like a child).
- Over the hill – Another way of saying that someone is old or past their prime
- no spring chicken - quite old or well past their youth

- Age before beauty - When this idiom is used, it is a way of allowing an older person to do something first, though often in a slightly sarcastic way.
- Come of age When something comes of age it develops completely and reaches maturity. When someone comes of age, they reach adulthood or fulfill their potential.
