

Parents,

Thank you so much for allowing us to minister to your child(ren) in our KidZone so that they can KNOW, GROW and GO in Christ! In order to better serve your children and ensure their safety, please be mindful of the following helpful hints and safety measures.

- Kindergarten – 2nd grades will be allowed to attend two of the service times, consecutively, without parents having to pick them up. During the middle hour we have Kidz Worship for K–2nd graders only.
- Children's bulletins are made available for children to use during the "adult" worship services. These contain the Pastor's sermon title, text, and notes and are designed to help children engage in the worship service. In addition, the bulletin contains activities and important announcements concerning the KidZone and upcoming events.
- An adult or high school-aged siblings may pick up children from the KidZone.
- Check-in times begin 15 minutes prior to worship services unless otherwise noted (only during the middle services). Please make every effort to drop off in a timely manner. Our teachers often prepare activities to reinforce their lessons, and if your child comes in late, they miss out on this important instruction.
- Please verify any notes on the screen for needed information (i.e. emergency contact information) upon check-in.
- We would also appeal to you to pick your children up within 10 minutes of the end of the service. Our volunteer teachers and leaders also have family responsibilities and want to attend service and adult Bible Fellowship classes. If you are late, so are they. Thank you for your consideration of other people in this regard.
- DO NOT drop off your child and leave campus (we need a parent/guardian on site in case your child needs emergency care).
- If you send another relative or non-relative to pick up your child, please make sure that individual has the proper security tag from you.
- If your child has an allergy or special medical needs, please contact Bryan Livingston. Often our teachers bring special snacks for the children and they are happy to make accommodations if necessary. Your child's safety is very important to us.
