

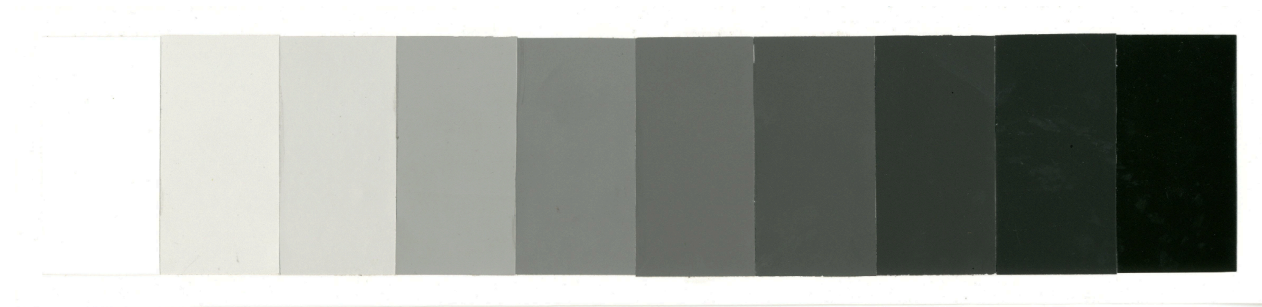
Value Scale Exercise

Outcomes:

Students will explore relationship of value with and without color

Students will mix and construct a progressive achromatic and monochromatic scale

Students will learn about shades and tints



Assignment Process:

1. Create a 10-step achromatic value scale by painting black, white, and 8 even steps of gray in between them. Paint areas of approximately 1" x 2" on watercolor paper.
2. Cut out each value step, 1"x2" section. Glue the gray chips in a vertical column to the left margin of the paper provided. See diagram below.
3. Similarly, create a 10-step monochromatic value scale by painting black, white, and one color of your choice and 8 even steps of gray in between them. Paint areas of approximately 1" x 2" on watercolor paper. Cut out the same size pieces and glue them to the right of the value scale so that the values should somewhat match between the scales.
4. Label your work Value Scale.
