Google Forms is a great tool for creating quizzes and surveys. But did you know that Google Forms can be used like this?




For years teachers and students have wanted to be able to see Kahoot questions and answer choices on the same screen. This week Kahoot finally made that possible!

## Share a Chrome Webpage to Another Device including Your Phone! Google


On your computer, open Chrome.

Go to the page you want to share.

Click the address bar and then "Send This Page"icon. Choose a device.

On your chosen device, you will get a notification about the page you've shared with yourself.

Tip: You can also right-click on a link or a page and then "Send to your devices".



In SpeedGrader, instructors can reassign an assignment to an individual student and ask them to redo their submission. In Course Settings, the Participation menu includes an option to select course dates by term or course. Files linked in the Rich Content Editor can be previewed in an overlay or inline.


