The document linked here is a template, if you have not been provided one, please make a copy for your responses. The question document also contains a checklist of services often found in commons. We are asking speakers to use that list to identify what features currently exist in their

- organization. There is room in the questionnaire to add any additional services that we may have missed.
- 8. The speaker has the option of creating a slide deck if they would like but that is up to them. The speaker may just share and speak to their responses in the question document if they prefer. If you are using a slide deck, please send it to us before or after your presentation.
- 9. We record the meeting and post it online for members to review. It will be included in the <u>list of previous meeting recordings</u>, but it's not on youtube or advertised more broadly. Similarly, your written response to the pre-meeting questionnaire will be available to working group members to review.
- 10. CJ will gather and compile your slide deck and questionnaire responses and will be in touch prior to the call to make sure you have the connection details.
