## AAPI Democrats Celebrate National Voter Registration Day With Voter Registration Training Event

**LAS VEGAS, NV** – In celebration of National Voter Registration Day, the Asian American and Pacific Islander Democratic Caucus (AAPIDC) hosted a voter registration training on Tuesday, September 28 at the SEIU Nevada office for members of the Asian American and Pacific Islander (AAPI) community.

According to the U.S. Census, Asian Americans increased their voter turnout rate more than other racial or ethnic groups between the 2016 and 2020 U.S. presidential elections. AAPI voters constitute the fastest growing racial or ethnic group in the U.S. and make up 10% of the electorate in Nevada.

"The right to vote freely and fairly is a fundamental right for all Americans, and AAPIDC is dedicated to ensuring that AAPI voices are heard at the ballot box," **said the AAPIDC.** "The first step in engaging AAPI voters begins with providing AAPI community members with easily accessible voter registration, which is why we are providing voter registration training to equip our members to serve as voter registrars in Nevada. Voting is the bedrock of our democracy, and it is through out vote that we have the power to amplify our vision for a better, fairer, and more representative future. We will continue to build this power for future generations of AAPIs."

National Voter Registration Day, first celebrated in 2012, has become an annual nationwide event, celebrated on the 4th Tuesday of September, mobilizing communities across the country to register eligible individuals to vote.
