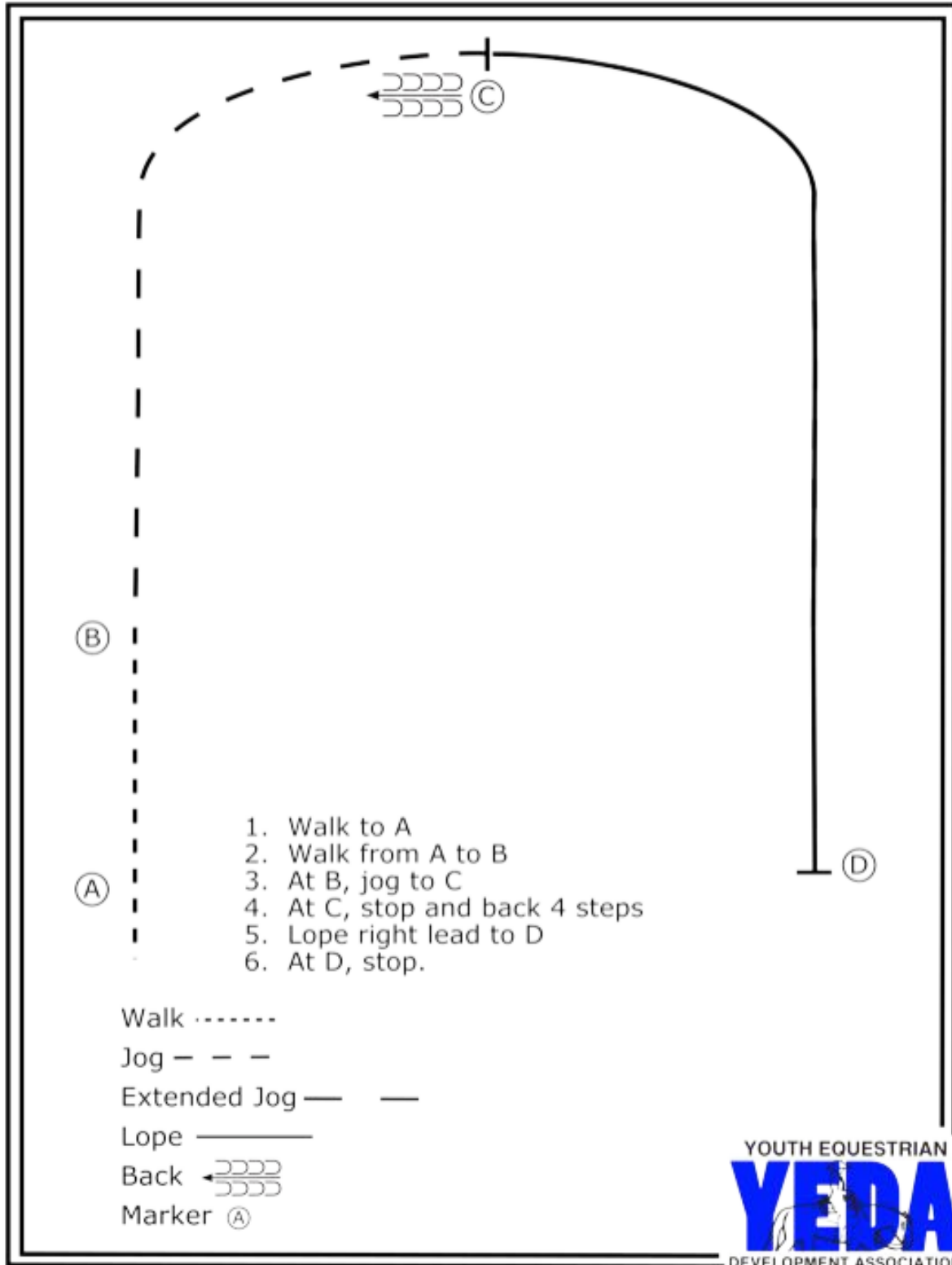

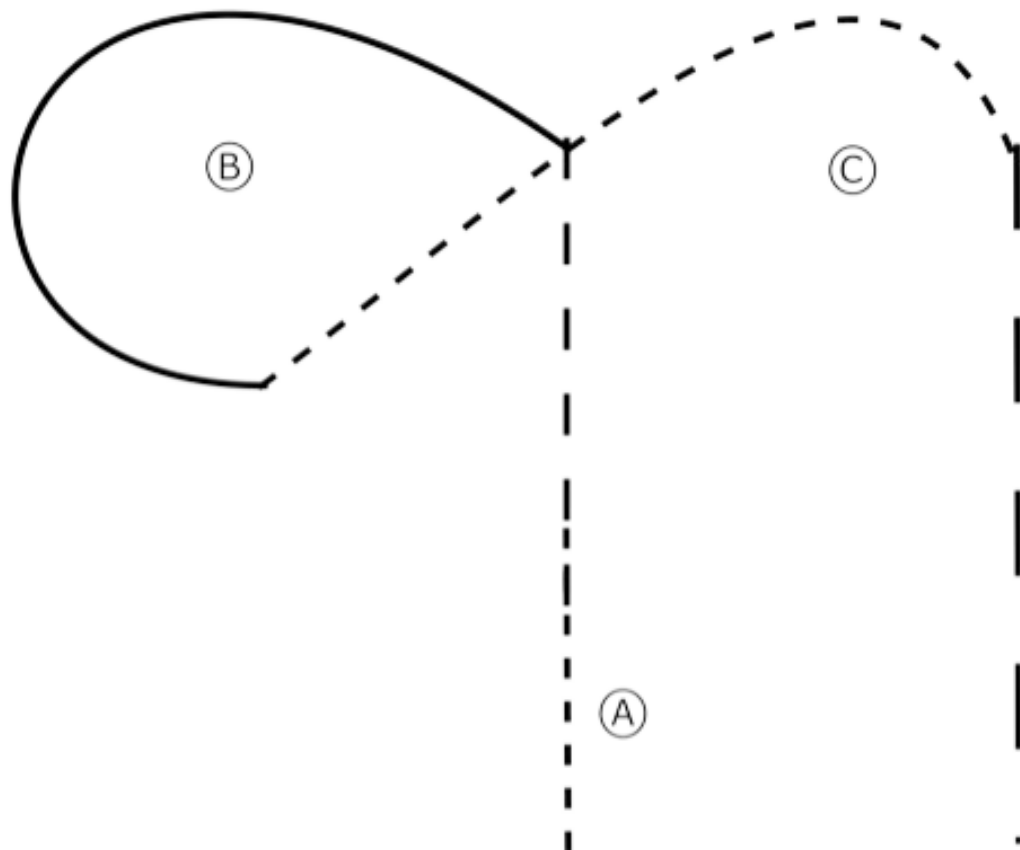

Diamond Pattern 4

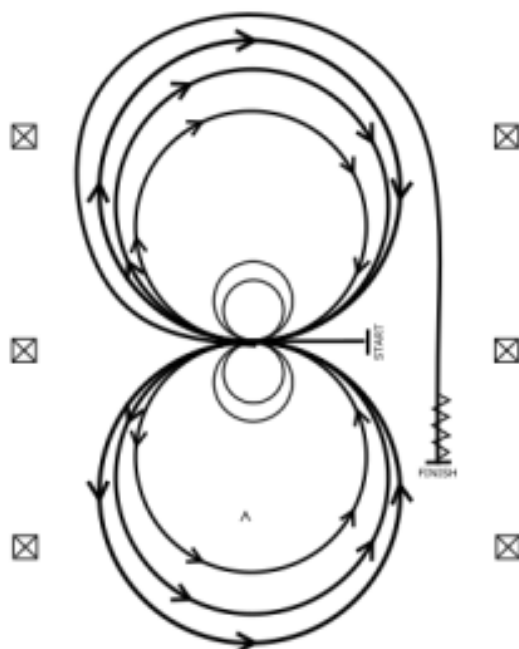


Ranch Riding Pattern 4

YEDA Reining Pattern 3,4



Riders may walk or jog to center of arena. Rider must walk or stop before lope off.

1. Lope off on the right lead. Complete one large fast circle and then on small slow circle. Stop in the middle of the arena. Hesitate.
2. Complete 2 spins to the right. Hesitate.
3. Lope off on the left lead. Complete one large fast circle and then on small slow circle. Stop in the middle of the arena. Hesitate.
4. Complete 2 spins to the left. Hesitate.
5. Beginning on the right lead, complete one large circle to the right, change leads in the center of the arena. Complete one large circle to the left. Change leads in the center of the arena.
7. Lope around the end of the arena. Do not close the circle. Continue straight past the center marker. Stop and back more than 4 steps. Hesitate to show completion of pattern.

Horse Descriptions

1. Applesauce (Concord) – Paint gelding. Hold to keep slow. Do not kick just click to go. Two handed, no crop and no spurs.
2. Ben (Keystone) – Can be very lazy. Kiss and outside leg to lope. 2 handed and division appropriate spurs.
3. Bonnie (Riding on Faith) – Ride full leg to seat and hand. Keep legs wrapped around for support. Hold steady on a center line. Use outside rein lift and leg for spins, don't rush. Spur broke. Keep in the bridle, shorter rein but soft. Keep outside leg back and body shaped while loping. 2 hands. Ball spurs only.
4. CB (Concord) – Sorrel gelding. Keep leg on while loping or will swap leads. Keep collected or will get long and strung out. Has a flying lead change. 1 or two handed just do not get reins too tight. Ball spurs or no spurs.
5. Charlie (Riding on Faith) – Keep hands low and balanced. Don't hang at the jog or he breaks. Has a good jog if you keep him settled. Set up for right lead. Use rein and seat to rate his stride back. Leg off and sit deep to stop. Can toss head so hold steady. Must squeeze to back and soft pull. Support his frame when passing on the rail so he doesn't break. 2 hands, division appropriate spurs optional.
6. Chase (EQD) – Sorrel/White APHA gelding. Guide with legs for better steering. Bump with legs for jog transitions. Set up for leads and support with lots of leg to keep the lope. Can be lazy. Two hand option. 2 hands better for patterns. Push forward into pivots or he'll pivot on the forehand. Squeeze and lift hand for back up. Division appropriate spurs, crop option.
7. Coco (Southern Ohio) - Bay QH gelding. Use quiet hands and consistent but light contact. He will pull against the bit if reins are too short or if you pull on his face. Responds to voice commands. Cluck and wave legs for jog. If you cue to aggressively or kick for jog, you will get a long trot. Kiss and outside leg pressure for lope. Responds best to easy/light legs/cues. Will respond to spur stop or neck rein. Spurs can be used to slow, collect, or set head and can be used according to division. However, spurs not recommended for riders not familiar with spur-trained horses, as you will not need spurs for forward motion and if they are used in that way, you will not get your best ride. He has very slow jog and lope with correct use of spurs or no spurs, but will move out with a (very safe, but faster) hunt seat stride with overuse of spurs or more aggressive cues.
8. Dawg (Puthoff) – Bay reining/ranch gelding. Feet off to slow and to stop 1 hand Division appropriate spurs but need to be dull.
9. Diesel (Hancock) – Light to medium contact. Lazy draw, but straightforward to ride. Set up for leads and use legs to keep rhythm for gaits. He does have a little higher head set. 2 handed horse. Ball spur or crop for walk/trot.
10. Earl (Buckeye Riders) – Sorrel gelding. Ride leg to hand. If he is pulling on hand, use legs to soften face (don't just pull harder). Anticipates roll backs to the left. Ask to stop (use hand but not too heavy in initial back up). 2 hand option. Ball spurs only!
11. Emma (Concord) – Grey mare. Fun ride. Can go really slow and be fancy if you ask her. 1 handed, ball spurs or no spurs.
12. Emmitt (Riding on Faith) – Simple. Knows his job. Can have a big whoa. Can get quick strided at lope but doesn't go anywhere. Leg off to stop. Pull to back. 1 handed. Crop option for walk-trot. Division appropriate spurs.

13. Genny (Concord) – Palomino mare. DO NOT get reins too tight! Easy to ride. Keep collected or will be bouncy. Ride with your leg on, if you take leg off she will stop. Do not over set up for lead changes or will kick out. 2 handed and no spurs.
14. George (Puthoff) – Sorrel gelding. Good draw. Knows leg cues. 1 handed. Division appropriate spurs.
15. Gretel (Hancock) - Fun Draw. Set up strong for left lead. Use a looser rein and allow her to flow forward. Changes leads well, use stronger cues for right to left change. Light to medium contact. One handed horse. Division appropriate spurs.
16. Gypsy (Keystone) – Ride with contact, moves off leg. No spur stop. 1 or 2 hand. Division appropriate spurs.
17. Hollywood (Buckeye Riders) – Don't hang on her face, pull and release or she will pull back. Set up for left lead. Keep her straight. 2 hand option, ball spur option.
18. Homer (Buckeye Riders) – Set up and maintain left lead. Can get anxious in the middle when preparing to spin. Can get quick in rollbacks. Finish your stops before allowing him to rollback. 2 hand option. Division appropriate spurs.
19. Ike (Hancock) - Great draw. Set up strong for leads. Super fun horse with lots to offer. Use a good balance of seat and rein. Light to medium contact. One handed horse. Division appropriate spurs.
20. Indy (Hancock) - Ranch Horse. Mostly seat ride, try to stay as soft as possible through your hand. Doesn't love a ton of contact with your hand. Sit deep and put your feet to her shoulders to stop. Whoa and flag legs to back. Use leg strong through lead change. 2 handed and no spurs.
21. Isabella (Golden Dawn) – Light contact on face, listens to leg. Cluck to trot, kiss for lope. Keep a quiet soft seat. 2 hand option. No spurs.
22. Jay (M & M) – Short rein, easy-leaded. Cue early in patterns, he takes a beat to downward transition. Hum to cue for downward transitions. Leg release to stop and back. Very basic. 2 hand only. Division appropriate spurs (may change, ck the board and his tag)
23. Jett (Southern Ohio) – Black QH gelding. Light rein contact and LOTS of leg/spur. If contact is too tight, he won't move forward. Use spurs according to division and if none are allowed, a crop is permitted. Cluck and kick for jog; kiss and cue for lope. Increase forward motion for flying lead change. Can be very lazy but does very well with a confident rider not afraid to use legs or spurs. Continue kissing and consistent leg contact through lope if he gets too slow/uncollected. Use inside leg and body position to keep him from cutting corners in rail work. 2 hand option for short/weak legs or those not allowed spurs, as his steering is very leg dependent.
24. Keme (DMB) – Soft rein contact. Keep asking for forward motion throughout all gaits. Keme will quit when given the opportunity but will step off willingly when asked. 2 hands. Ball spurs only.
25. Kid (M & M) - Reining typey. Feet away to stop. Stick lead transitions. Ask for lead changes quietly. Usually lazy. 2 hand option all patterns. Division appropriate spurs.
26. King (Buckeye Riders) – Good draw! Soft/smooth hand and legs. Keep engaged in circles to prevent swapping leads. Division appropriate spurs.
27. Latte (Buckeye Riders) – Typically laid-back. Can get anticipatory in patterns particularly rundowns. Use soft hands and keep nose straight with body. Keep her moving forward using even leg pressure. Don't rush her with quick hand or motions. 2 handed. Ball spurs.
28. Legend (M & M) - Reiner typey. Feet release to stop back. Can be forward. Medium rein. Hum for downward transitions 2 hand OPTION for patterns. Ball spurs only.

29. Mayze (Concord) – Palomino mare. Smooth ride. Be assertive when loping off. 2 handed and no spurs.
30. Melody (EQD) – Red Dun QH mare. Needs ridden with soft contact but not a lot of bit pressure. Support with leg for lope. Spurs needed for lope. Division appropriate spur and crop ok for walk trot.
31. Opie (Hancock) - Pleasure horse. Bump your legs in rhythm to maintain a good speed. Great lead departures. Doesn't mind contact as long as he is supported with leg. 2 hand and division appropriate spurs.
32. Peach (Double B's) – Chestnut Quarter Horse. You need to be soft but firm when asking. Squeeze to slow down, you set the speed and she will go slow. Will drop her head and work into the bridle. To lope off, do not kick, just apply pressure to your outside leg and support her shoulder with your inside. One handed. NO SPURS.
33. Peter (Concord) – Bay gelding. Fun ride. Doesn't take a lot of leg. Very handy. 2 handed and division appropriate spurs.
34. Prada (DMB) – Soft rein contact. Keep asking for forward motion throughout all gaits, with a rhythmic leg. She will get frustrated with strong, constant pressure from leg or hand, but will continue to do her job. Prada will quit when given the opportunity but will step off again willingly when asked. Does not have a flying lead change but can do all the rest of the Ranch maneuvers. 1 or 2 hand option. Division appropriate spurs.
35. Precious (M & M) - Reiner typey. Feet release to stop and back. Hum for downward transitions. Very easy. Usually lazy. Two hand OPTION for patterns. Crop option for walk-trot. Division appropriate spurs.
36. Quinn (Hancock) - Reiner. Fun Draw. Support through the middle to avoid lead change. Try to use a looser rein and ride with more seat to achieve better response. Guide slightly through the start of the turnaround. Can be a choppy stopper. Whoa and flag legs to back. One handed horse. Ball spurs for Reining and ranch only.
37. Riley (EQD) – Sorrel QH gelding. Light rein contact. Soft legs. If he wants to go slow, let him. Don't be pushy. - Soft cues for leads and pattern work. Soft legs for jog transition, soft consistent push for lope. Division appropriate spurs, but don't overuse them.
38. Roxie (Double B's) – Black Quarter Horse. Loose rein. Very easy and straightforward. Cow bred style mover. To lope off do not hold her back with your hand. Drop it down and kick with the outside leg. One handed. Ball spurs optional.
39. Sassy (M & M) – Very basic and easy. Watch right lead. Hum to slow to next gait. 2 hand option for patterns. Division appropriate spurs.
40. Saxby (Concord) – Sorrel gelding. Big handsome man!! Fun to ride, keep collected to keep slow. 2 handed and ball spurs or no spurs.
41. Slick (EQD) - Straightforward draw. Light to medium contact. Can be lazy. Use your legs to keep a rhythm and to keep him forward. Crop option for walk/trot. Ball spur.
42. Sophie (DMB) – Will jog a hole in the ground and can lope (low quality) equally as slow. If you choose the slower lope you will have to ride every stride. Walk is a bit forward compared to her slowest other gaits. Soft rein contact is best with Sophie. She does collect up with leg pressure, but will collect up with rein too, as long as you ask with your voice to keep moving. 1 or 2 hand. No spurs.
43. Stu (Southern Ohio) - Sorrel QH gelding. Light contact; spur trained and will need strong legs or crop if no spurs allowed. Cluck to jog and kiss to lope. Division appropriate spurs.

44. Sweet (Concord) – Paint mare. So smooth!! Can get anxious in patterns. Talk to her and be assertive. Set up for right lead. 1 handed and no spurs.
45. Tori (Concord) – Pretty roan mare. Set up for right lead but do not get reins too tight. Soft hands when asking to stop and back, otherwise will throw head. 2 handed and no spurs.
46. Wall-E (M & M) - Lazy. Basic. 2 hands. Medium rein. Crop option walk trot. Division appropriate spurs.
47. Whiz (Concord) – Chestnut gelding. Fun, fun horse. Easy to ride. Pull softly for stops. 1 handed and division appropriate spurs.
48. Zip (Puthoff) – Sorrel gelding. Very lazy! Set up for right lead! 1 handed. Division appropriate spurs.

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RIDING TEAMS

Alfred University fields competitive hunt seat and western Intercollegiate Horse Show Association (IHSA) riding teams and an Intercollegiate Dressage Association (IDA) dressage team. All teams are fully funded and recognized by the University as varsity sports, meaning that there are no out-of-pocket expenses for team members.

IHSA competition is open for all levels of riders to participate, with classes from Walk-Trot and Walk-Jog through Open Equitation on the Flat and over Fences and Open Horsemanship and Reining. Riders compete on horses provided by the host school, meaning that students do not need to have their own horse in order to show in college. Tryouts for each team are held at the start of the fall semester. Individuals not selected for the varsity team will have the opportunity to ride on the junior varsity team, which provides a stepping stone for many riders to advance to the varsity level the following year.

The IHSA season runs the duration of the school year, with eight regular season shows from late fall through early spring and post-season competition continuing through the first week of May. Alfred University's teams have achieved great success throughout the years, with multiple regional championship and reserve championship team and individual titles and qualifications for zone, semi-final, and national competitions. Most recently, a hunt seat team member finished as Reserve National Champion in her division, and an AU western rider has been the AQHA High Point Rider for the region five years in a row, receiving automatic qualification to the National Finals.

Currently, all of the regular season western shows for the region and two regular season hunt seat shows are held at the Equestrian Center. Alfred University is also the IHSA Zone 2/Region 1 regional president college.



The Bromeley-Daggett Equestrian Center

The Bromeley-Daggett Equestrian Center at Alfred University, located at the Maris Cuneo Equine Park, was constructed in 2005 to provide state-of-the-art accommodation for equestrian classes, JV and varsity riding teams, horse shows, clinics, and community events.

The 400-acre facility is just five minutes from the AU campus. It is completely heated and includes classrooms, offices, several viewing areas, 56 stalls for university horses and student-owned boarders, a heated 200' x 80' indoor arena, and two lighted outdoor arenas (240' x 120' and 120' x 90'). Ample turnout is available, and several miles of trails wind through the woods and surrounding area.

Directions to the Equestrian Center: Travel south on Main st. in Alfred. Drive approximately 2 miles up the hill, and turn right on Lake Rd. The center will be on your right.

Located just a few minutes from campus with acres of fields and liesure trails, the AU equestrian facility and program offers a unique opportunity to combine your chosen academic interests with your passion for horses through classes, two minors, and competitive riding teams.



EQUESTRIAN STUDIES

Academic/Theory Classes

The equestrian program offers a variety of classroom-based theory courses each semester on topics such as Equine Science, Equine Management, Methods of Teaching Riding, Hunter/Jumper Course Design, and Horse Show Judging. In addition, Special Topics are offered each year on a rotating basis: in recent years, these have included Care of the Equine Anatomy, Equine Veterinary Science, and one of our most popular classes, The Equine Business in Ireland, which concluded with a ten-day trip to Ireland at the end of the semester.

Riding Classes (Activities Classes)

Quality riding instruction is offered in hunt seat, western, and dressage, with classes offered for all levels from beginner through advanced. Upper level courses in disciplines such as reining, reined cow horse, and combined training are also offered for more advanced riders. Riding classes fulfill any major's PE requirements as long as classes in two different disciplines are taken.



Equestrian Studies Minor

Any student, regardless of major, is welcome to pursue the Equestrian Studies minor. Sixteen credits are required to fulfill the minor, a combination of academic or theory classes and activity classes (riding). The structure of the minor is flexible, allowing students to build their course of study around their specific equestrian interests.



Equine Business Management

The program created in partnership with the AU College of Business, allows students interested in pursuing a career in equine business to combine introductory courses in management, finance, marketing, and entrepreneurship with practical courses that apply those skills to the equestrian industry.

Other Activities

All classes and other activities, including open horse shows and clinics, offered at the Equestrian Center are open to any student, regardless of their major or involvement with the equestrian program. Private and group lessons are also available for all levels of riders.



Boarding Horses

Alfred University students are welcome to bring their own horse to college with them, although students are not required to have their own horse to participate in any activities in the program.

The Equestrian Center offers full care board, which includes a 14% pellet feed, mixed grass/hay, automatic waterers, daily stall cleaning, and daily turnout (weather permitting).

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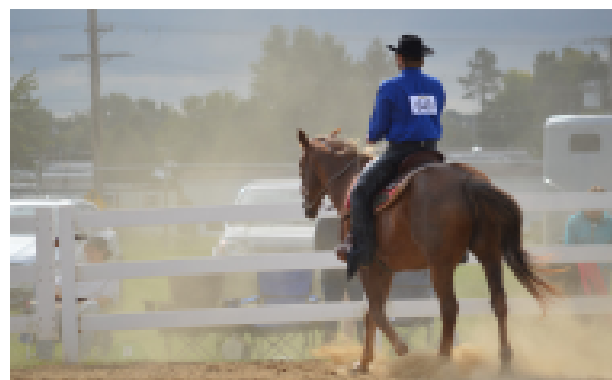
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
