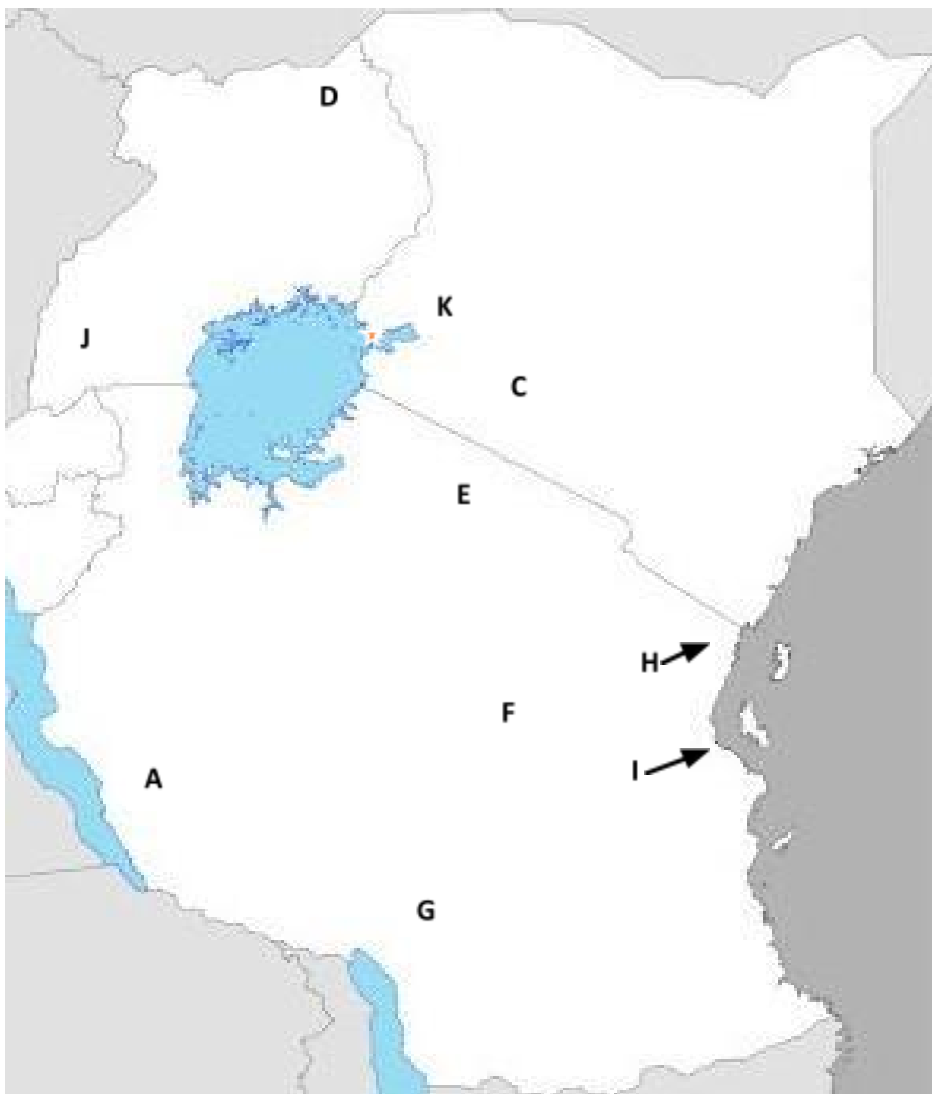


1. MAP OF EAST AFRICA SHOWING HISTORICAL SITES

F – Kondoa Irangi: Rock painting of early man

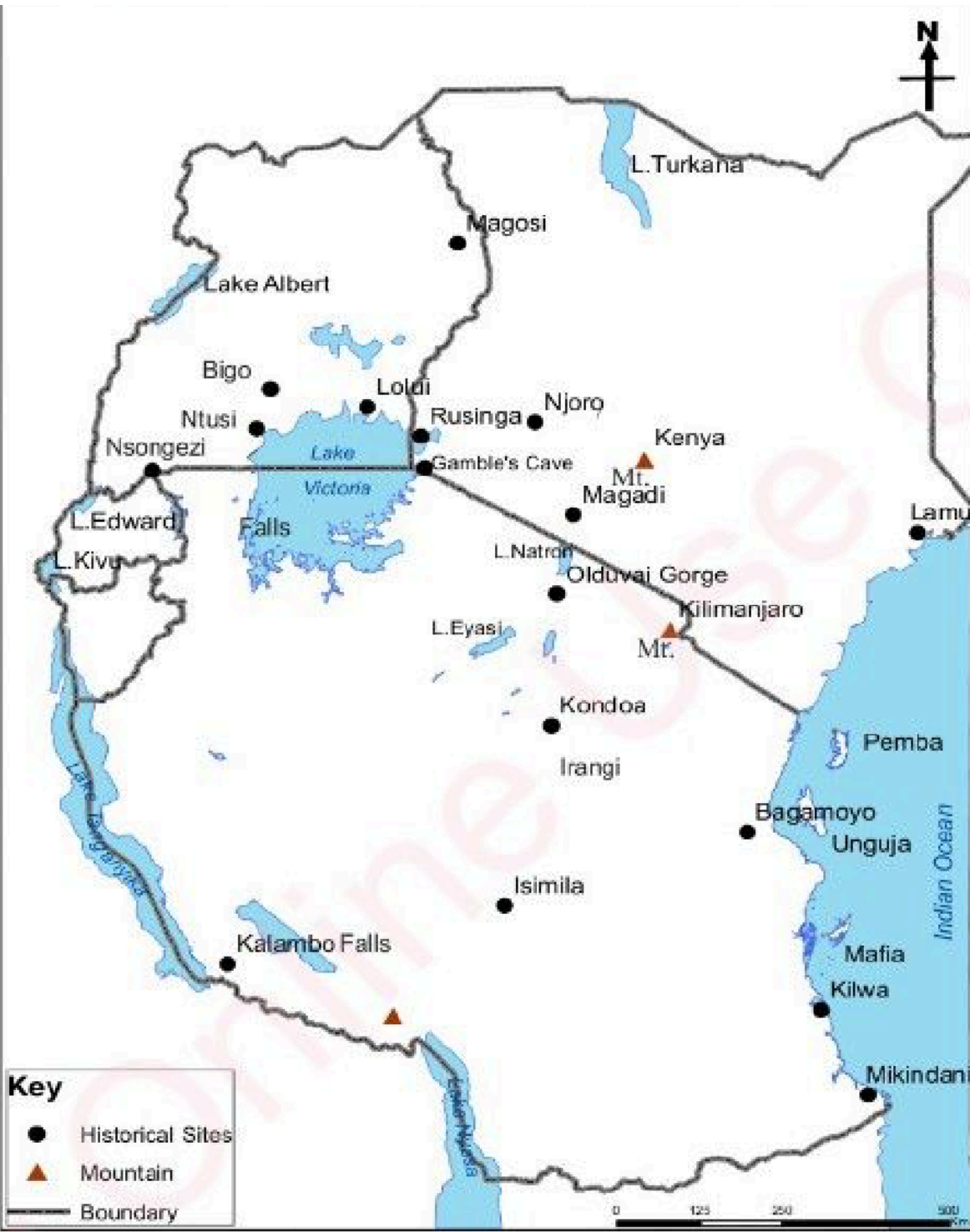
G – Kalenga Museum: the skull of Mkwawa kept

J – Bigo: Settlement of Bachwezi, first people in Uganda



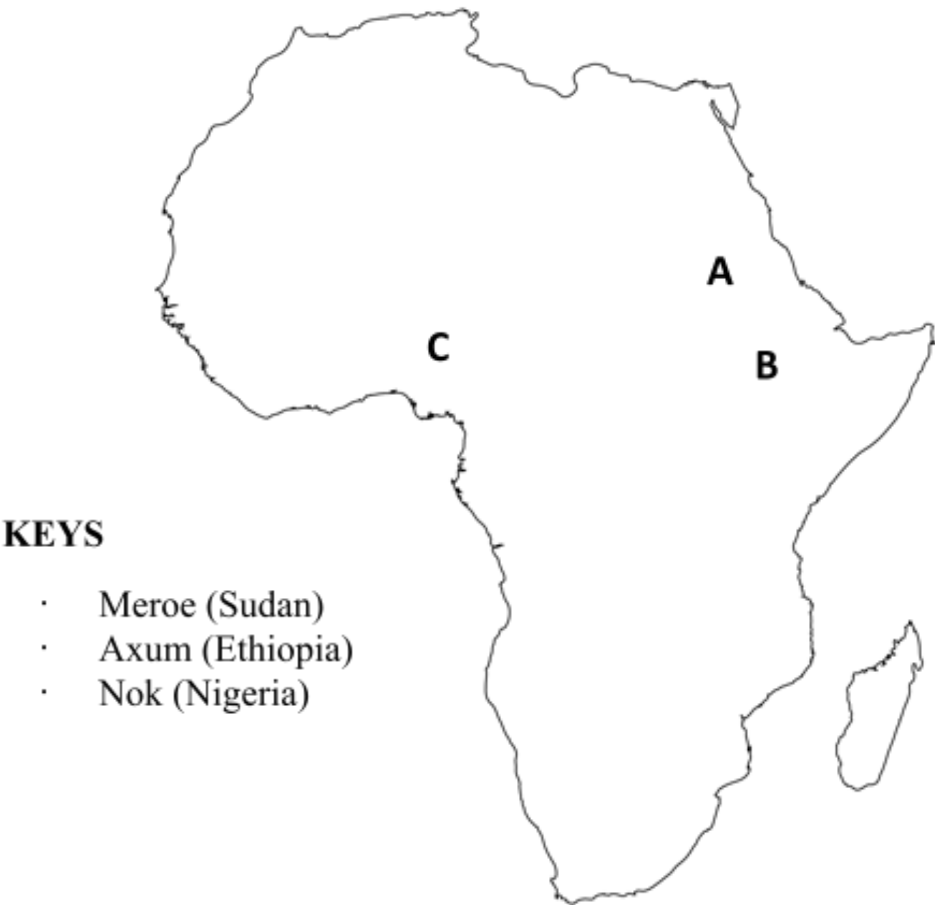

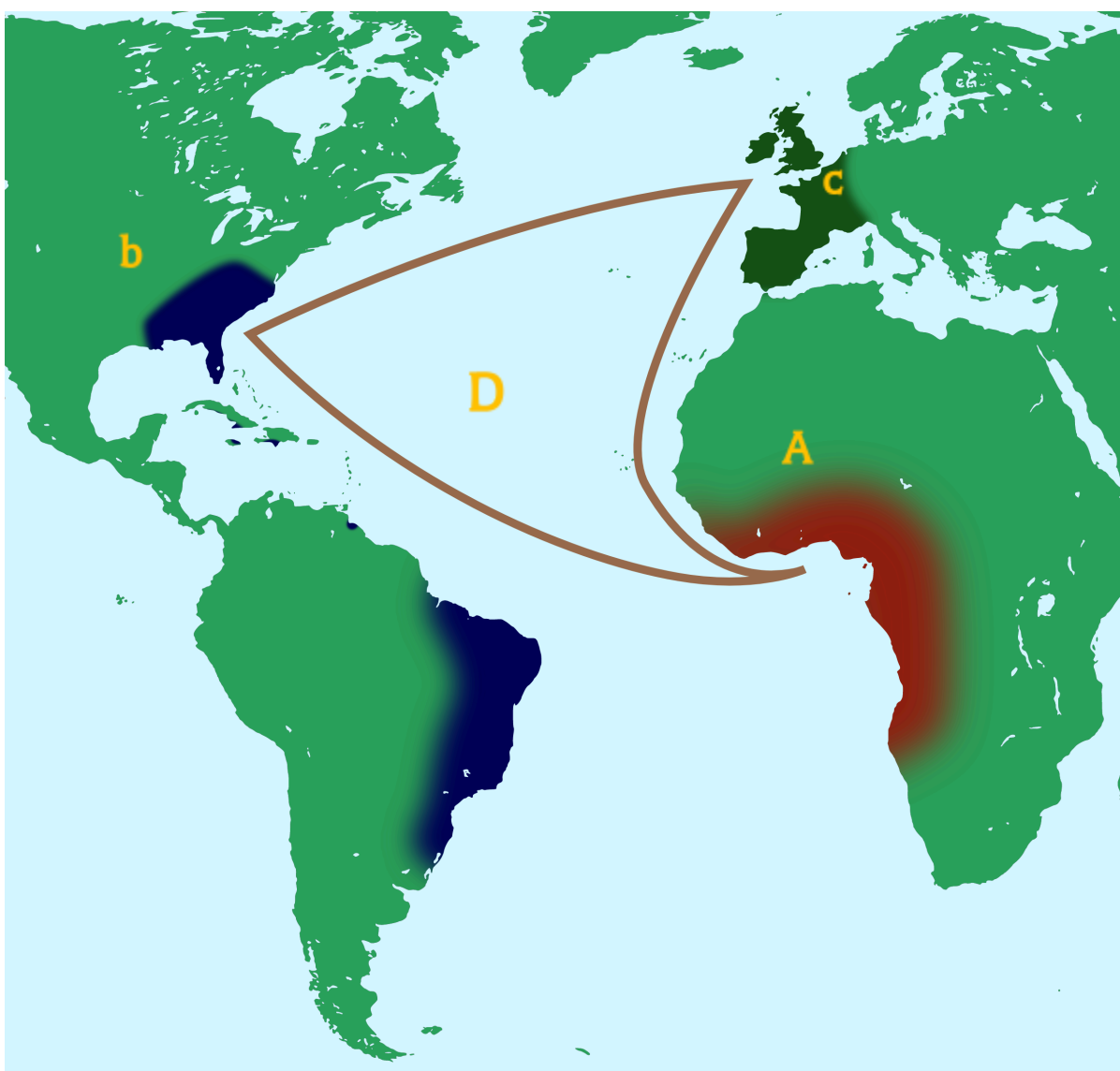

A-AFRICA

Goods taken to B

- i. Slaves, mainly from west Africa
- ii. Natural resources like minerals,

Forest products like animal skins, sea products like cowrie shells and tortes shell

B- AMERICA (indigenous were called *red indies*)

Goods taken to C were raw materials like tobacco, sugar and sisal

C-EUROPE

Goods taken to A were manufactured goods like clothes, wine and mirrors.

D-ATLANTIC OCEAN

The ocean where trade conducted on as a means of transportation, simply because it connects all three continents.

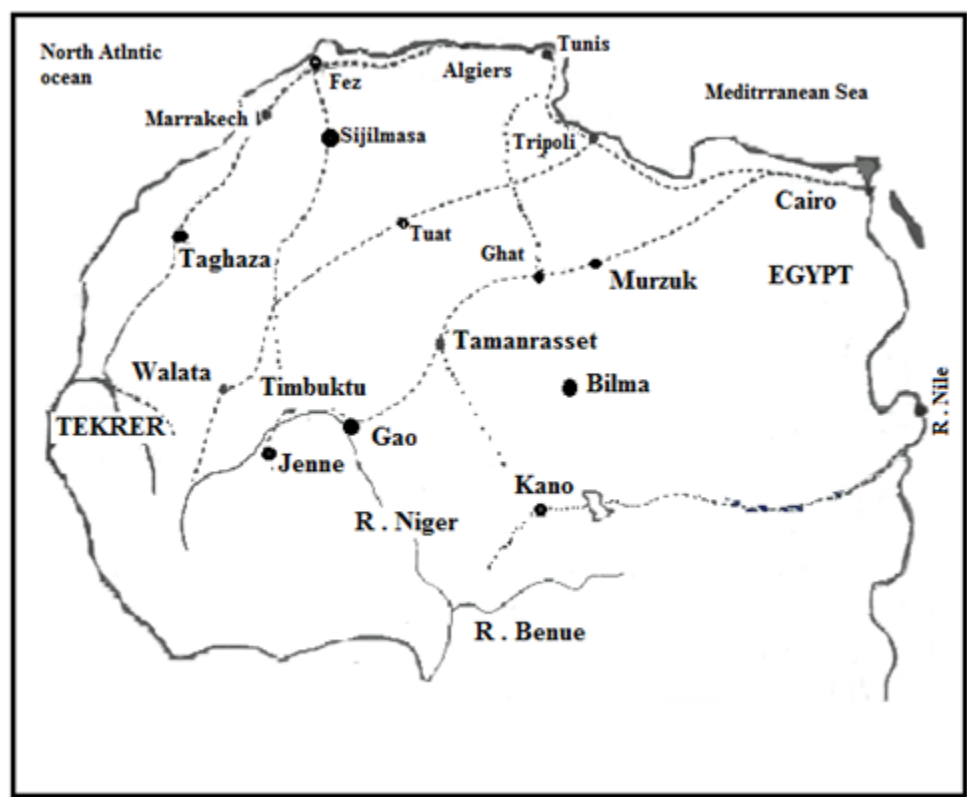

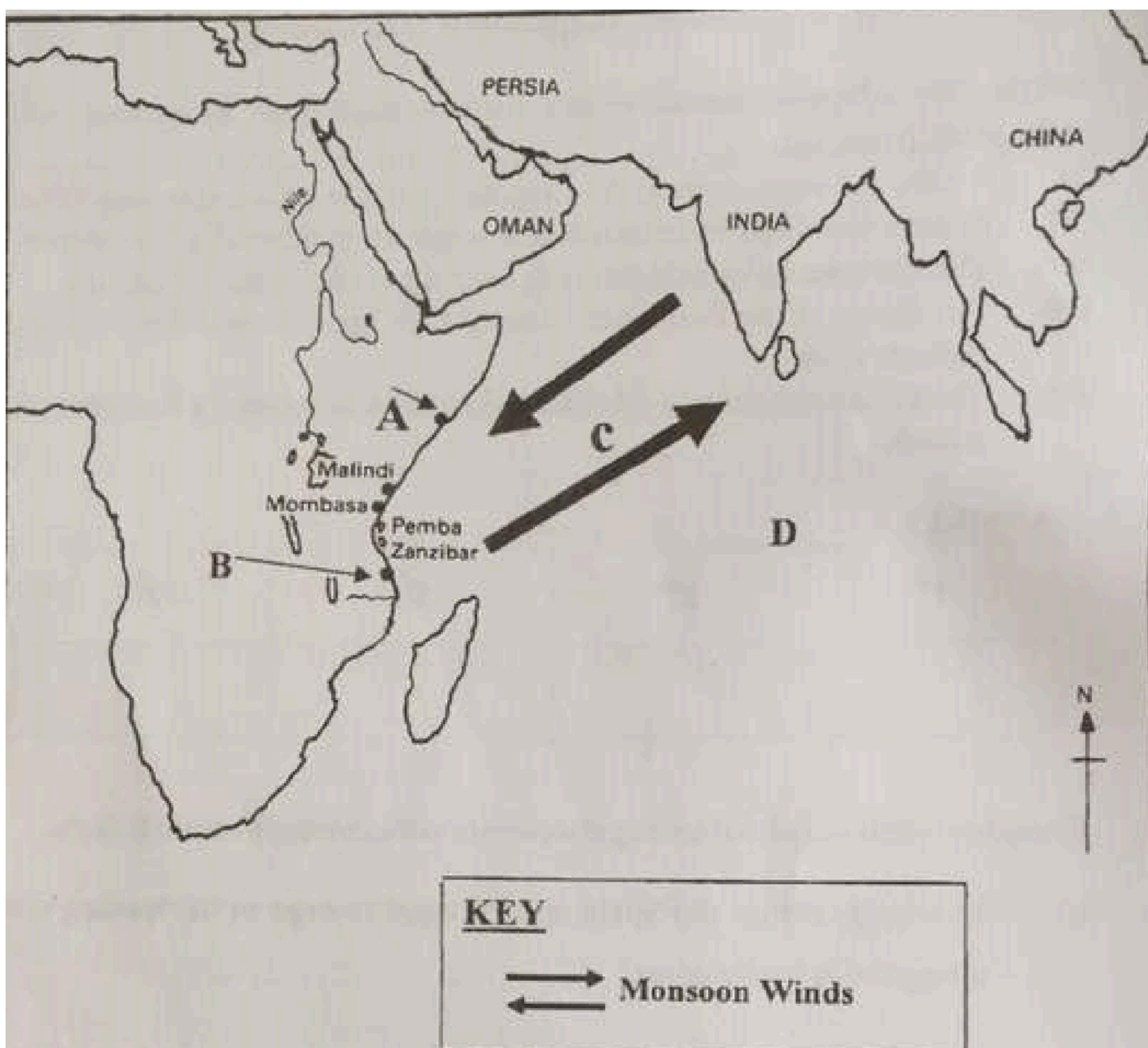
