Calendar

The Board of Trustees has officially approved the WRPS Learning Calendar for the next three years following a comprehensive review and feedback process. Nearly 500 survey responses from families and staff, along with public engagement meetings, student input, and consultations with school administrators, informed the decision. The approved calendar meets all legislative and instructional hour requirements while ensuring equity in instructional time across schools. Key considerations included optimizing learning time before final assessments and addressing feedback on fall break. Winfield School will operate with four fewer days to accommodate transportation challenges.
