Course registration for campus students occurs in April, and we are happy to take new student course requests beginning after your enrollment.

To begin the course registration process, you should first submit the completed transcript from your child's previous institution to our [Registrar's office](#). Students will need to submit their completed transcript prior to formally registering for classes at SBS. We recognize that final transcripts will not be released until June for many schools. Please make every effort to submit complete transcripts by **July 15** in order to guarantee a spot in your course requests.

Next, you may make your course requests by filling out the form below. Please read our [2025-2026 Course Catalog](#) so that you understand our course offerings and requirements.

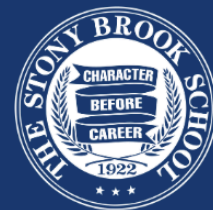

Math Placement

Math placement is primarily done by transcript evaluation and teacher recommendation. Sometimes, we ask new students to take a one-time skills test to best discern the proper class. The Academic Office will be in contact with you to arrange a skills test to assess the best placement in our math curriculum.
