Whereas, over the past several years, many college campuses, including the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, have fallen victim to mass shooting events that have caused loss of life and severe injuries to students, and;

Whereas, on April 30, 2019, the University of North Carolina at Charlotte had a shooting in the Kennedy Building that caused the fatalities of Riley Howell and Ellis "Reed" Parlier, and injured 4 other students, and;

Whereas, on November 13, 2022, the University of Virginia had a shooting that took the lives of Devin Chandler, D'Sean Perry, and Lavel Davis, Jr., and injured 2 other students, and;

Whereas, on February 13, 2023, Michigan State University had a shooting that took the lives of Arielle Anderson, Brian Fraser, and Alexandria Verner, and injured 5 other students, and;

Whereas, according to the Gun Violence Archive, in the year 2022, there were 647 separate mass shooting incidents, and in 2023, as of February 15, 2023, there have been 71 separate mass shooting incidents.

Therefore, be it resolved by the Student Senate of the University of North Carolina at Charlotte:

SECTION 1: The Student Senate of the University of North Carolina at Charlotte hereby shows continued support and solidarity for the members of the college campus communities that have

fallen victim to mass shooting and other mass casualty incidents, including but not limited to, Michigan State University and the University of Virginia.

SECTION 2: The Student Senate of the University of North Carolina at Charlotte further recommends the continuation of annual ceremonies, recognizing the continued acts of gun violence occurring around the country and specifically remembering the lives lost during the April 30, 2019 University of North Carolina at Charlotte shooting.

SECTION 3: The Student Senate of the University of North Carolina at Charlotte further condemns all acts of gun violence and expresses the continued advocacy for ending acts of gun violence that occurs at schools, malls, concerts, and all other public venues.
