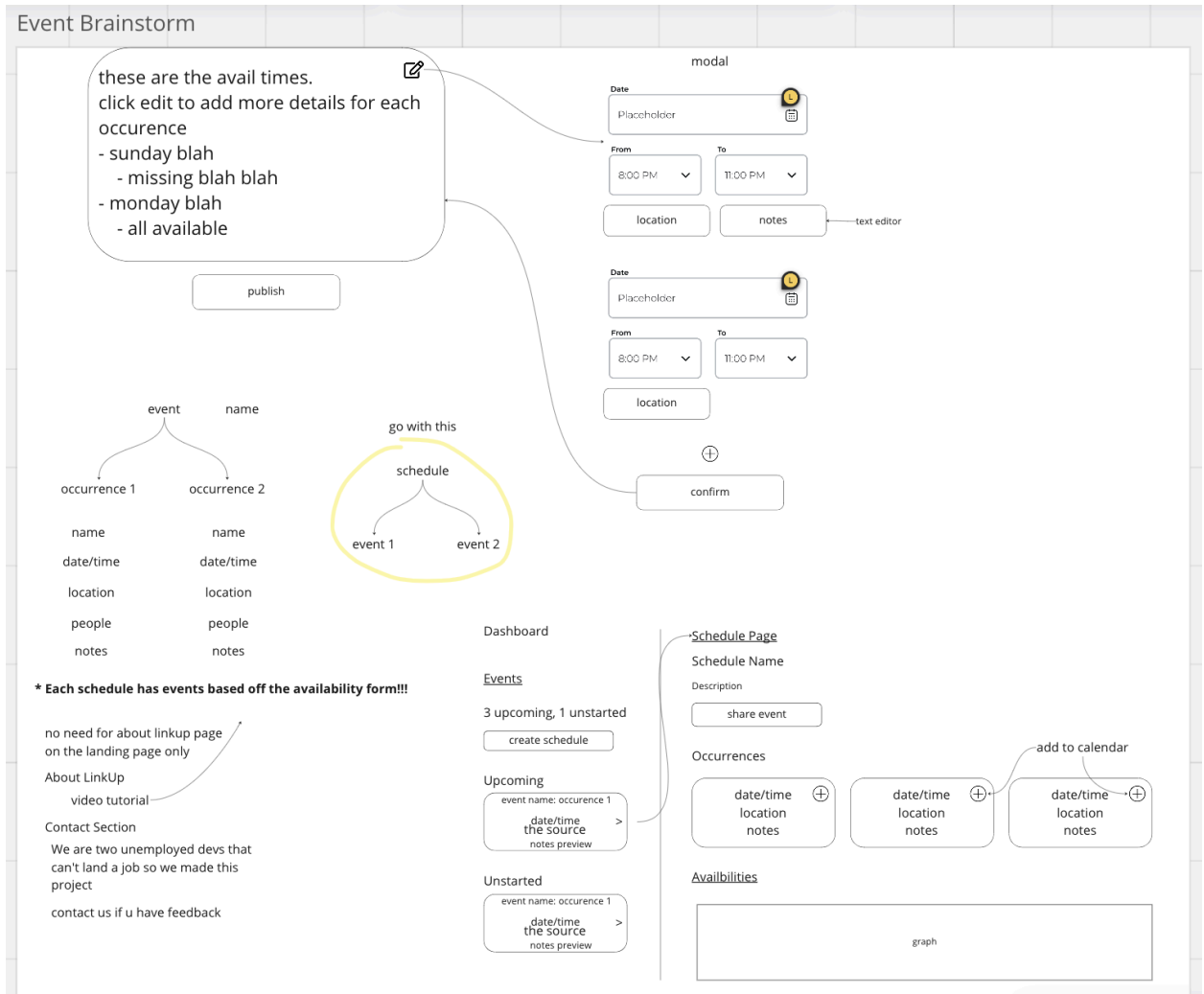

`respond_to` is a method on the superclass `ActionController`. it takes a block, which is like a delegate. The block is from `do until end`, with `[format]` as an argument to the block. `respond_to` executes your block, passing a `Responder` into the `format` argument. Feb 29, 2012
