Content	Timing (60 min)	Leads
<b>Opening/Welcome - Setting the context for the Meet-Up</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Welcome to all participants</li> <li>● Present the event focus and the rationale for it</li> <li>● Overview of the agenda and structure of the event</li> <li>● Request participants to complete the registration sheet</li> </ul>	5 min.	Meet-Up Organizer
<b>Getting to know participants and expectations</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Each participant introduces themselves with name, organization (if any), country of residence/work</li> <li>● Each participant expresses their expectations for the event either verbally or by typing in the chat</li> </ul>	10 min.	Meet-Up Organizer
<b>Sharing of challenges and best practices</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Each participant briefly shares research, work opportunities, best practices, and resources</li> <li>● Questions and responses are solicited from the wider group</li> </ul>	30 min.	Meet-Up Organizer
<b>Wrap-up</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Summary of key takeaways and suggestions/ raised in the discussions</li> </ul>	10 min.	Meet-Up Organizer
<b>Closing</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Closing remarks, including continuing the engagement via INEE channels</li> </ul>	5 min.	Meet-Up Organizer
