1. General Guidelines

- You are allowed to use a single, static PowerPoint slide for your presentation.
- Please ensure there are no slide transitions, animations, or any form of visual movement on the slide.
- The slide must be displayed from the start of your presentation and cannot be altered during your talk.
- Please note that the use of additional electronic media, such as sound or video files, is not permitted.
- Similarly, no props—including costumes, musical instruments, or laboratory equipment—are allowed.
- Your presentation must be strictly limited to 3 minutes.
- Any presentation exceeding this time limit will result in disqualification.
- Presentations should be delivered as spoken word and must begin directly from the stage.
- The time begins when you initiate your presentation, either by speaking or through movement.
