FY23 SWENext Recruitment Challenge - Rules and Regulations

We challenge you to recruit the most SWENexters before May 31, 2023!

The top 3 sections/affiliates/MALS to recruit the most SWENexters (see the attached Rules and Regulations) by May 31, 2023, will receive a monetary award: 1st place - \$500 2nd place - \$300, and 3rd place - \$200 to be used towards future outreach events.

The top 3 SWENext Clubs to recruit the most SWENext Members (see the attached Rules and Regulations) by May 31, 2023, will receive a monetary award: 1st place - \$100 2nd place - \$75, and 3rd place - \$50 to be used towards future outreach events.

Rules and Regulations

- 1. Sections/Affiliates/MALs and SWENext Clubs must opt-in to participate and create a unique Event Code (See the attached FAQs for information on how to create a unique Event Code.)
 - a. Prior Recruitment Challenge Participants may use their unique event code for the FY23 SWENext Recruitment Challenge; however, they must still opt-in to participate.
- 2. The top 3 winners in each tier must be in good standing
 - a. Good standing requirements include sections/affiliates/MALs/SWENext Clubs that have registered with SWE HQ, have contact information for their section/affiliate/MAL/SWENext Club advisor available to SWE HQ.
- 3. The top 3 winners in each tier must recruit a baseline of SWENexters. More is always better!
 - a. Sections/Affiliates/MALs: The top 3 winners must have recruited at least 30 students each. (More is always better!)
 - b. SWENext Clubs: The top 3 winners must have recruited at least 20 students each. (More is always better!)
- 4. Rules regarding previous winners:
 - a. FY22 SWENext Recruitment Challenge top three winners are ineligible to receive a monetary award for the FY23 SWENext Recruitment Challenge; however, they are eligible for an FY23 honorable mention. FY22 winners are strongly encouraged to participate in the FY23 challenge and continue inspiring the next generation of STEAM leaders!
