


The ItsTheZimmy V. KaiGuy Situation

Although there were people that voiced their opinions, a majority of them just spammed and flooded the comment section.


Immediately after the hate raid happened, Vernam had joined my server and tried to DM me.


Meanwhile, my editor and I was in DMs trying to figure out what happened, my editors suspects Denni due to the #savedenni


spam and encouraged me to do something about it. So, I tweeted about the spam, throwing shade at Denni who potentially caused the hate raid.


In the meantime, I was in a conversation with Vernam:























NOTE: When the video was edited, the GDMastery site did not show the 3 courses on the sign up page. I did not read the other parts of GDMastery.

While I do understand that I made a rash claim that KaiGuy's course was a scam. It did not deserve to be posted on Vernam's server publicly.

Vernam should have known better that this can only result in witch hunting and instead should have reached out to me privately or even join the dialogue in the comment section of the video.

In the meantime, a KaiGuy associate reached out to my editor to figure out a way to calm down the situation.




Note: At that time, KaiGuy's associate assumed that Denni had done something based on my tweet.


In the meantime, KaiGuy's associate also messaged me to try and get a hold of the situation. It was at this point that I started to think that Denni was not involved with the raid.

Then, Vernam began mocking me for privating the video, without knowing what actually happened in the background




Then, my editor messaged me asking to take down the post as it definitely wasn't orchestrated by Denni but I was already asleep at the time so I was only able to take it down the next morning but luckily the tweet did not get much attention.

The next day, KaiGuy's associate informed my editor that KaiGuy was willing to have an open conversation with myself alongside Denni in a group chat.


I figured that this would be an opportunity for me to finally have a proper discussion and express my criticisms to the literal creator of the course himself

In return to him and Denni agreeing to do an open discussion with me, I made an apology to KaiGuy and Denni on the community post of my channel alongside my twitter:




This was pretty much due to making sure that when the group chat did happen we were all on good terms. Keep in mind however I was still suspicious about the course during this.




But for KaiGuy to randomly leave and not say anything, felt like a huge betrayal to me, as if he ran away from the open discussion.


But then, Denni responded to me and explained that KaiGuy was just busy and was unable to do the open discussion.

Once the re-edit was uploaded I once again started getting DMs from vernam again. He pretty much continued to add criticisms to the vid and also gave me a very interesting link...






In the screenshots, you will see that apparently the original post that started the entire hate raid on my channel came from a russian GD telegram that was in denni's channel.

Now I did not click on this link since I'll be honest, I did not trust the link at all. But IF it did come from denni's channel then I'm very disappointed that it spread like wildfire the way it did.

During this also, I also got a DM from KaiGuy who criticized the video after essentially leaving me on read prior to leaving the group chat unexpectedly.

Not only was a lot of this completely out of nowhere considering he left me on red for weeks after leaving the group chat. But he also decided to leave a bombshell of a dm to me which I am honestly shocked by.

The way he attempts to try and read my life, like I was suffering from crippling depression to then brag to me about how he is helping kids out of suicide is disgusting to me. I would never use anyone's messages which tell me that I have helped them through their life as a weapon to try and tell others "look man, look how good I really am".

I am extremely disappointed in Kaiguy in terms of his attitude and how he decided to respond to me when I give any criticism towards him. One personal tangent from me, I had respect for you Kai believe it or not, but after that bro... I have lost all the remaining respect I had

So yea, I hope this whole doc fully details the whole timeline of everything that happened in the background so any speculations and confusion can be cleared completely.

I hope this can finally end this unnecessary drama, I hope that KaiGuy and his team can take my criticisms of the marketing of their course and apply them effectively.
