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## 1. Presentation Quality: Judge the presentation, boards, visuals, and artifacts

5 – Outstanding	Presentation is exceptionally detailed, clear, engaging, well-organized, and articulate. Visuals and artifacts strongly enhance understanding of the project.
4 – Superior	Presentation is very detailed, clear, appropriate, organized, and articulate. Visuals and artifacts strongly support the project.
3 – Excellent	Presentation is somewhat detailed, clear, appropriate, organized, and articulate. Visuals support the project.
2 – Very Good	Presentation is basically detailed and clear, but may lack organization or depth.
1 – Developing	Presentation lacks clarity, organization, or sufficient detail.

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### 2. Step Up Youth Challenge Components: Does the presentation address the required components?

Components (1–4):

- **Meet the Need:** Meets a school or community need
- **Community Collaboration:** Coordinates with community agency, another school, or the community at large
- **Impact:** Impact on the school or community
- **Sustainability:** Provides a plan for sustainability

2 – Very Good	Presentation addresses 2–3 components of the Step Up Youth Challenge.
1 – Developing	Presentation addresses fewer than 2 components or components are unclear.

3 – Excellent	Most team members participate; students are knowledgeable and articulate.
2 – Very Good	Some team members participate; students are somewhat knowledgeable and articulate.
1 – Developing	One student does most of the presentation; limited team participation.

2 – Very Good	Students provide basic responses with limited reflection.
1 – Developing	Students struggle to explain their learning or project purpose.
