Placement Exams for the Major:

1. MAT 1010 will fulfill the math requirement for this major. You can register for MAT 1010 regardless of your SAT/ACT score and you do not need the Math Placement Test. Consult with your academic advisor if you want to consider a higher level math course for any reason.
2. [Language Placement](#)- You must take a foreign language sequence of classes for this major and therefore need to take a language placement test.

First-Year Student Course Recommendations:

1. Enroll in **ART 1001**
2. Enroll in **ARH 2030**
3. **R C 1000 or UCO 1200 if there are seats available. If not, it's fine to take both classes in the spring semester.
4. Choose a General Education GEN ED (SCL - ICL - HUM) Enroll in one **course**.
5. Choose a General Education **Wellness Literacy** course
