Below is General Student Registration Information - **Current Silver Creek HS Students** **Class of 2027, 2028, 2029** **[Calendar LINK](#)**

For current 9, 10, and 11th grade students at Silver Creek:

- October 29–November 10: Know your options and available programming **(in all classes & advisory)**
- November 10 & 12: make your preliminary choices **(in advisory)** worksheet provided
- November 18 & 19: in put your preliminary choices in your Course Planner **(in advisory)**
- November 19 – January 22: Individual student – counselor conferences to review selections and make final choices.
- January 25 – February 11, Verification window for audition & application/special classes: Students notified IF they did not get into any application, audition, CETC, or IC class.
- February 11 – course selections emailed to parents/students – opportunity to address questions
- May 1th – schedules released via Infinite Campus

Please read all the directions below as they will take you step by step through the registration process. Dates will be important to note.

What should I be doing now to prepare for registration?

- October - November 10: Review the course and student handbook with your parents to identify the classes that you want to take for the 2026-27 school year. (See the Course and Student Handbook link.)
- Ensure that you have conversations with your teachers about electives that require an audition or application.

 - If an audition class, such as Symphonic Band, you will register for the class. You will be notified between January 23 – Feb. 11 only IF you did NOT get into the class.
- Ensure that you have conversations with your teachers and counselors about the selection of your core classes for the 2026-2027 school year.

Be aware of electives that require an application and/or audition deadlines.

- You will register for these classes during the normal registration timeline.
- After registration window, a list will be generated. This list will be approved by the teacher.
- During the window of January 23 – February 11, any student who was not approved will be contacted. You will be contacted only IF you did not get into the class.
- Students are contacted via email, so it's important to check emails during this time.
- You will need to check the band, choir, and orchestra websites for specific timeframes. Yes, you can choose the class, but you will also need to audition during the specific window.

If my teacher recommends me for AP, do I still need to fill out an application?

- **No, you will choose any AP class that you would like to take.**
- **During the verification window of January 23 – Feb. 11, lists will be generated to ensure that students have the correct prerequisites. If students do not have the correct prerequisites, they will be placed in the on-level or one of their alternates will be chosen.**

When will I know if I have been selected for Audition or application classes?

- You will choose and select the class during the window.
- If a band, choir or orchestra, you will need to follow the audition window timeline outlined in their websites.
- Verification Window – January 23 – Feb. 11: If a student has selected an audition class, but does not make the class, the student is notified during the verification window via email. The first listed alternates will be chosen.

How will I select my core (English, Science, Social Studies and Math) classes?

- You will make these selections during the regular registration window – same as your electives.

How will I know which core classes that I am going to take?

- You will make your selections and then have an opportunity to review the selections with your counselor.
- When you visit with your counselor, you will lock in your final selections.
- **Individual student-counselor meetings will be held Nov 19 – January 22.**

Can I take additional core classes as electives?

- Yes, if you need to retake a failed class or you'd like to take additional classes in an area of interest, you may select additional core classes.
- You will need to speak with your counselor

Is it **really necessary to choose all those alternate electives? - You NEED 8 Alternates!!**

- **YES!** If one or more of the electives that you have selected do not fit into your schedule, we review your alternate selections. If you do not have any or do not have enough to choose from, we make the elective selection for you. We do not want to do that, so please be sure to choose 6-8 alternate electives.
- Every year there are students who do not choose enough alternate electives. When this happens, they are put into classes by the school. Once the master schedule is complete, schedule changes are not a guarantee and are subject to seat availability.

What if I change my mind later regarding the electives that I requested and the window is closed?

- It is very important that you carefully consider and select your electives as well as verify your teacher recommendations. The master schedule, created in March, is completely built upon student requests.
- Once the schedule is built, unless there is an error, schedule changes are not a guarantee and are subject to seat availability.
- On Feb 11, a list of courses will be emailed to students and parents. There will be one week to identify any changes. After this verification period, it will be too late.

When will I see my 2026-2027 schedule?

- Final schedules for 2026-2027 will be available in Infinite Campus on May 1. It is important to verify your schedule prior to the start of the school year.

- Schedule Change Requests: On-line requests during the window of May 1 - May 8, 2026. .

What registration assistance is there?

- Counselor and administrative staffed virtual open-lab nights are: January 14 and 21, 5:00-7:00 pm.
- If your student has an IEP and needs assistance with appropriate course selection, please contact your student's appropriate counselor and case manager.

If I am currently a student at Silver Creek and do not plan to attend during the 2026-27 school year, do I still need to register for classes?
