**Step 1:** Choose an entrepreneur.

**Step 2:** Research your entrepreneur and answer these questions:

- Who is your entrepreneur?
- What business/ businesses did your entrepreneur start?
- What inspired your person to become an entrepreneur?
- What skills does your entrepreneur possess? (At least 3)
- What impact has your entrepreneur had on their community?
- Include all the web resources used in your research

**Step 3:** Create a slide presentation in Google Slides. Include the following slides:

- Title Slide – Entrepreneur name
- Slide 2- Business
- Slide 3- Inspiration / Path
- Slide 4- Skills or Characteristics
- Slide 5- Impact on Community
- Slide 6 – Resources

**Step 4:** Add slide presentation to list
