## **Characteristics of Good Questioning**

Q	Quality	Don't waste your time on questions that are unclear, confusing, or irrelevant.
U	Understanding	Make sure your questions lead to an understanding of content.
E	Encourage Multiple Responses	Questions with more than one answer lead to higher levels of thinking.
S	Spark New Questions	If your question encourages students to ask more questions, you've struck gold!
Т	Thought Provoking	Prompting students to think is the truest aim of good questions.
I	Individualized	Customize questions to your content and to your students.
О	Ownership shifted to students	Give students the opportunity to create their own questions.
N	Narrow and broad	Some questions are focused, some more open-ended. Use a balance. This is particularly helpful with close reading in the CCSS.
S	Success Building	Remember the goal of all questioning: successful student learning.
