

Earth Keeping - End of unit ideas

Throughout this unit we have discovered three main themes in Earth-keeping. We can honour creation by serving. We can honour creation by standing in awe of creation. We can honour creation by changing our perspective. In this unit you will be asked to honour creation in some way, reflect on it and present it to your peers at the end of the unit. The actual service learning project should take an hour of your time.

Earth-keeping by serving creation.

You are to honour creation by serving it in some way. Possible options could include: volunteering at your local Humane Society, cleaning up litter at your local park, creating a presentation or posters encouraging recycling at your school, or pick your own. Be sure to take pictures for your presentation.

Earth-keeping by standing in awe.

You are to honour creation by creating something that will encourage students to stand in awe of creation. Possible options could include creating and displaying an art piece of a part of creation that causes you to stand in awe, research a part of creation that causes you to stand in awe, display photos in a creative way to encourage your peers to stand in awe of creation, or pick your own.

Earth-keeping by changing perspective.

You are to honour creation by presenting a human action from the perspective of God's creation. Possible options could include performing a play you have written that encourages your peers to see creation in a new way, writing a story from the perspective of one of God's creation, creating a video from creation's perspective or pick your own.
