TRANSPORTATION & TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS: If you do not currently have a program proposal/itinerary, please explain what air travel, airport transportation, local transportation to and within the host country, (MC van, trains, buses, etc) that you anticipate using with any available details. Consider using public and more sustainable forms of transportation. Ask providers to include strategies.
ACCOMMODATIONS: What lodging is included? Please specify the number of nights and expected accommodation (hotel, hostel, homestay, etc) for each location in country. Please note whether or not you will be requesting MC on-campus housing for students prior to or upon return from the program and which days. (additional cost to student or part of program price) Indicate if accommodation is locally-owned. Staying at locally owned hotels helps keep and circulate money within the respective communities.
What meals are included? What is your estimated budget for meals that are not included. Be sure to include estimated costs of meals not included on the budget sheet under "Individual Additional Student Expenses" Indicate if included meals will be provided by locally-owned establishments and how meal experiences will provide cultural experiences. Eating at locally owned places helps keep and circulate money within the respective communities.
