

# Chonky parrot

## Beginner amigurumi crochet pattern

### Need:

Light pink yarn  
Dark pink yarn  
Black yarn  
Plastic eyes  
Stuffing  
Crochet hook  
Needle  
Scissors

### Tail (in dark pink):

Row 1. 6 sc into a magic ring (6)  
Row 2. 6 inc (12)  
Row 3. 'Sc, inc' x6 (18)  
Row 4. '2 sc, inc' x6 (24)  
Row 5-7. 24 sc (24)  
Slip stitch and cut, leaving a tail for sewing  
Sew the tail in half without stuffing

### Feet (in black):

Row 1. 6 sc into a magic ring (6)  
Row 2. 6 sc (6)  
Slip stitch and cut

Repeat twice to make 2 feet

Stuff and sew both feet onto the bottom of the parrot

Stuff and sew the wings onto either side of the body, and sew the tail onto the back

### Body (in light pink):

Row 1. 6 sc into a magic ring (6)  
Row 2. 6 inc (12)  
Row 3. 'Sc, inc' x6 (18)  
Row 4. '2 sc, inc' x6 (24)  
Row 5. '3 sc, inc' x6 (30)  
Row 6-7. 30 sc (30)

Put the eyes in between rows 6 and 7 about 8 stitches apart

Row 8. '9 sc, inc' x3 (33)  
Row 9. 33 sc (33)  
Row 10. '10 sc, inc' x3 (36)  
Slip stitch and cut

In dark pink (starting anywhere in the previous light pink row):

Row 11-18. 36 sc (36)  
Row 19. '4 sc, dec' x6 (30)  
Row 20. '3 sc, dec' x6 (24)  
Row 21. '2 sc, dec' x6 (18)  
Stuff the body  
Row 22. 'Sc, dec' x6 (12)  
Row 23. 6 dec (6)  
Finish stuffing and close

### Wings (in dark pink):

Row 1. 6 sc into a magic ring (6)  
Row 2. 6 inc (12)  
Row 3. 'Sc, inc' x6 (18)  
Row 4. '2 sc, inc' x6 (24)  
Row 5-7. 24 sc (24)  
Slip stitch and cut, leaving a tail for sewing onto the body

Repeat twice to make 2 wings

For the beak, just embroider a triangle onto the face between the eyes with black yarn
