In these difficult times when the response to the Coronavirus crisis is forcing a substantial reduction in economic activity in Italy - <u>and in particular in the greater Milano area</u> - we are gathering ideas on how to help from afar.

There are people all over the world that have strong ties to Italy, and many that have especially strong ties to the city of Milan, because they grew up, studied, or worked there.

To those people, this document aims to provide some practical ideas to help answer the "what can I do?" question. Although buying a small government bond or a "Made in Italy" product may feel like an insignificant drop in the bucket, there is strength in numbers and every action counts.

All in all, we're in uncharted territory, and it's easy to feel that there is simply nothing you can do.

We reject that.

How about other areas hit by Coronavirus?

Absolutely, help is and will be needed in many places. This is a global problem that requires global solutions. That said, locally focused ideas and solutions help as well. It's like when you donate to a local chartify AND to a global one. The two actions are not in conflict, but rather they complement each other. What matters is that there is action, instead of inaction.

Buy Italian government bonds

Italy is likely to issue new debt to inject cash into the economy. Buying Italian bonds via your brokerage firm may not be that easy, but a shortcut is to buy shares in a bond fund that focuses on Italian government bonds, such as iShares Italy Govt Bond.

With regard to the risk associated with Italian government bonds, this <u>recent Walls Street</u> <u>Journal article</u> stresses that the risk is low. The ECB is likely to be a buyer soon, as part of a stimulus package that will surely be implemented in response to the crisis.

Buy Lombardy Regional Bonds, when available

The Italian region of Lombardy successfully issued regional bonds in the past (e.g. 1 billion Euros in 2014). We should encourage the region to fast track the issuance of new bonds, so that private & public investors from around the world can immediately lend money to it

Interest rates are low, and investors may be willing to subscribe at a rate that is further discounted because of the nature of the bonds (<u>current rates for Italy's government bonds</u>).


A petition could be started asking Lombardy to issue special bonds as soon as possible, specifically targeted to economic relief in the areas most affected by the reduction of economic activity triggered by the Coronavirus outbreak. 
