Description of her appearance

Bonnie greets and introduces her name, no name sign, and position. She is not an ASL teacher; she is an artist. She describes herself as the woman, straight and her pronouns as she, her and hers. She also describes her appearance with brown hair with little gray hair on the sides, brown eyes, a white person with fair-colored skin. She wears a black polo shirt with the Ohio ASLTA logo. The event here at the hotel will have the ASLTA National Professional Development Conference next year June 28 to July 1, 2023. The Conference theme is "Embracing Our New Future and Beyond". She is announcing that the Deaf Art Gallery will display the Deaf Artworks for two months - June 1st to August 1st. The Deaf Art Gallery theme is "Art, That!". In the Deaf Community, people tend to sign "that, that, that". She adds another reason; the Deaf artists discover their identity and talents and paint into those arts. Deaf artists who are Deaf, Hard of Hearing, DeafBlind, Individuals with Hearing Loss, Deaf with Disabilities, CODA (Children of Deaf Adults), BIPOC and LGBTQIA (showing on both black sides of the screen) are invited to display artworks in the Deaf Art Gallery.
